

Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal

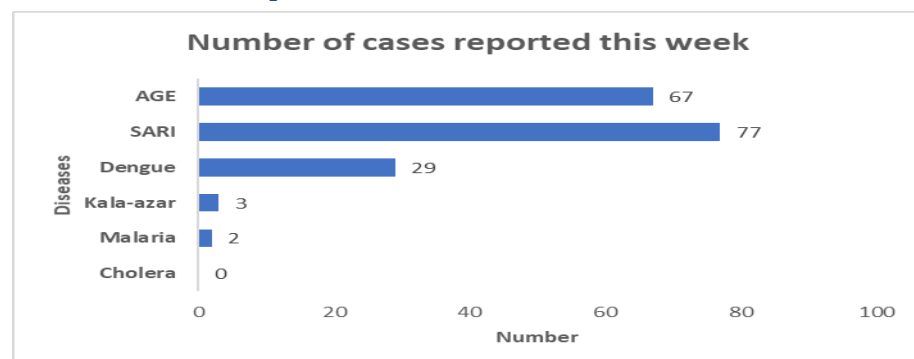
35th Epidemiological Week

6 September 2020

Highlights

- 46257 cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed so far in Nepal, of which 28941 cases have been discharged from the hospital.
- Of the reported cases, Severe Acute Respiratory Infection was the leading cause of morbidity in week 35.

Number of cases reported for each disease this week

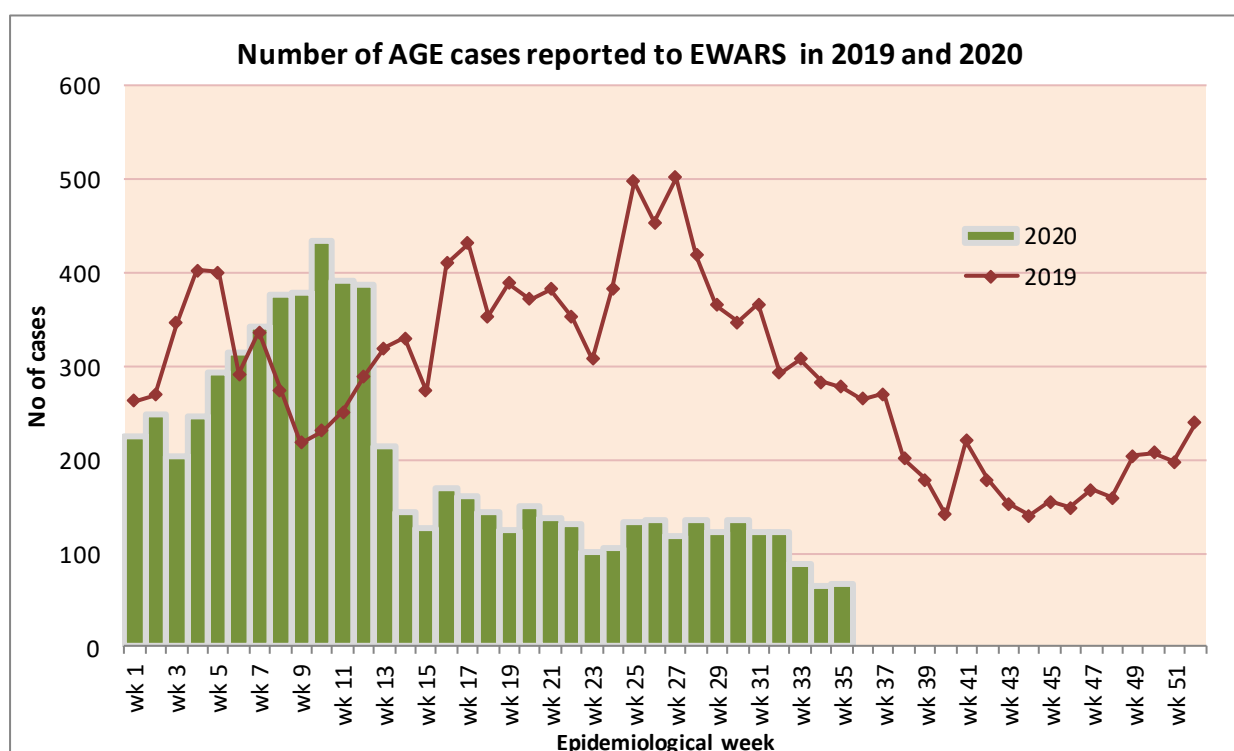


Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2020 till date, including comparison of the same period last year. Since May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

Morbidity

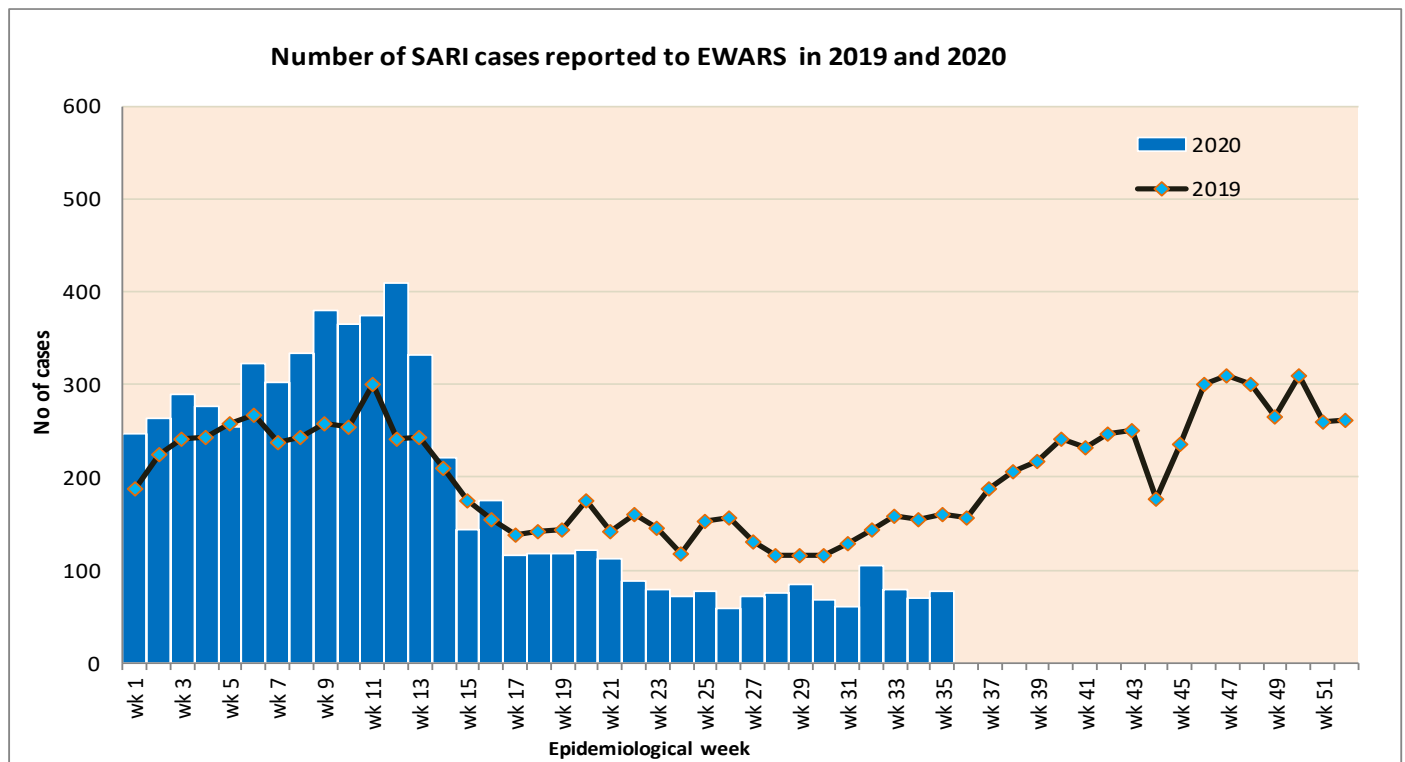
1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE) and Cholera

- 67 cases of AGE are reported this week. The majority of these cases are from Pyuthan (6 cases), Kailali (6 cases), Siraha (6 cases) and Kathmandu (6 cases).
- 278 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2019.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 77 cases of SARI are reported this week. The majority of these cases are from Bajhang (9 cases), Bhaktapur (7 cases), Kathmandu (7 cases) and Rupandehi (6 cases).
- 160 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2019.



3. Malaria

- Two cases of malaria are reported this week. One each from Panchthar and Kanchanpur.
- Seven cases of malaria were reported this week in 2019.

4. Dengue

- 29 cases of dengue are reported this week. The majority of cases are from Myagdi (7 cases), Baitadi (5 cases), Dadeldhura (5 cases) and Kailali (3 cases)
- 446 cases of dengue were reported this week in 2019.

5. Kala-azar

- Three cases of kala-azar are reported this week. One each from Okhaldhunga, Tanahu and Kailali.
- Five cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2019.

Other diseases

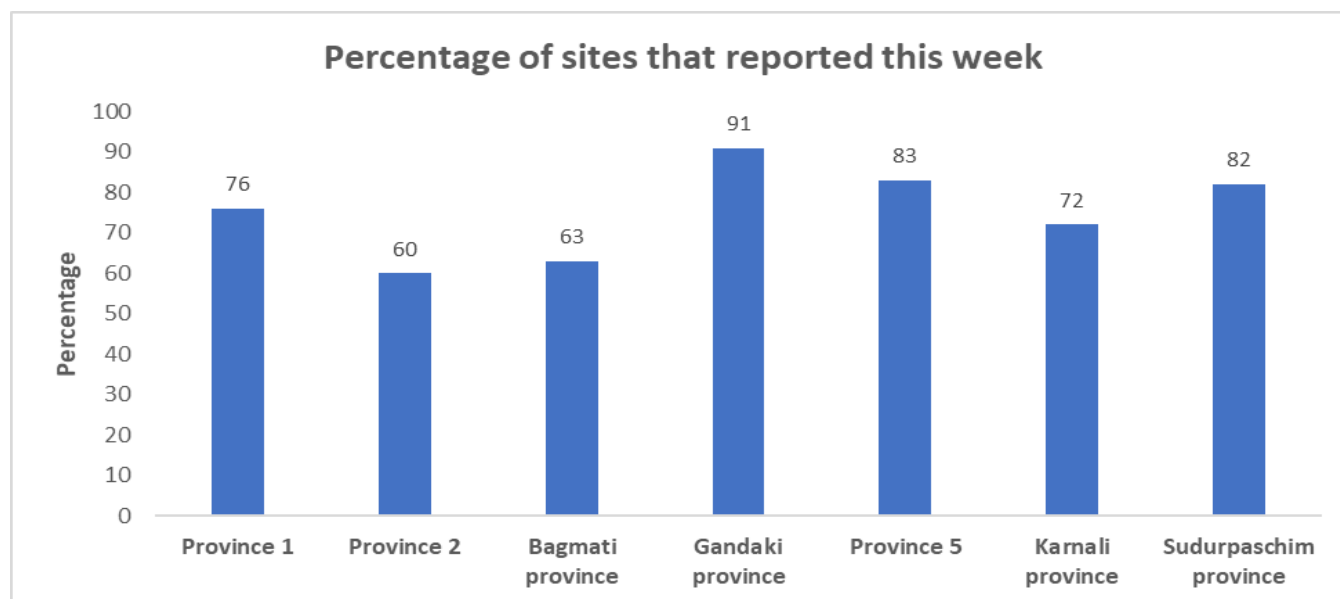
Scrub typhus

- 120 cases of scrub typhus are reported this week. The majority of the cases are from Bajhang (21 cases), Baitadi (14 cases), Palpa (13 cases), Achham (12 cases) and Gulmi (10 cases).
- 83 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2019.
