


#### **Highlights**


Among the reported diseases, **SARI** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 14 with **588 reported cases**.


Overall reporting rate of Week 14 is **98.5%** with **132 out of 134** sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provices of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

#### **Summary Observation (including probable and suspect cases)**

Most of the AGE cases were reported from PARSA (44 cases), KATHMANDU (42 cases), KAILALI (33 cases), RUKUM WEST (16 cases) and BARA (16 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (62 cases), SUNSARI (40 cases), MORANG (36 cases), RUPANDEHI (23 cases) and KAILALI (22 cases).

Most of the Cholera cases were reported from BHAKTAPUR (19 cases), MYAGDI (2 cases), UDAYAPUR (1 case) and BHOJPUR (1 case).

Most of the Malaria cases were reported from BAITADI (1 case), RUPANDEHI (1 case), GORKHA (1 case) and KATHMANDU (1 case).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (8 cases), SUNSARI (8 cases), RUPANDEHI (5 cases), SYANGJA (4 cases) and PANCHTHAR (3 cases).

Most of the Kala azar cases were reported from HUMLA (1 case), KAVREPALANCHOK (1 case), DHADING (1 case), DHANUSA (1 case) and SUNSARI (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DANG (13 cases), CHITAWAN (8 cases), DADELDHURA (5 cases), BAJURA (5 cases) and GORKHA (5 cases).


Most of the Enteric Fever cases were reported from DARCHULA (13 cases), KATHMANDU (9 cases), JHAPA (7 cases), PARSA (6 cases) and BARA (6 cases).

Most of the Influenza Like Illness cases were reported from KAILALI (79 cases), PARBAT (35 cases), BHAKTAPUR (35 cases), ACHHAM (29 cases) and KANCHANPUR (25 cases).
