
Highlights

Among the reported diseases, **AGE** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 20 with **762** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 20 is **94.9%** with 112 out of 118 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.


1003568 cases of Corona Virus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991509 cases have been recovered so far.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (61 cases), RUPANDEHI (42 cases), PARSA (40 cases), KAPILBASTU (38 cases) and KAILALI (32 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (48 cases), RUPANDEHI (19 cases), MORANG (18 cases), KAILALI (17 cases) and ACHHAM (14 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (12 cases), JHAPA (9 cases), ARGHAKHANCHI (4 cases), LAMJUNG (3 cases) and OKHALDHUNGA (3 cases).

Malaria Vivax case(s) were reported from KAILALI (1 case).

Malaria Falciparum case(s) were reported from (1 case).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (6 cases), KAILALI (1 case), SURKHET (1 case), PALPA (1 case) and LALITPUR (1 case).


Cholera case(s) were reported from RAUTAHAT (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DADELDHURA (12 cases), DARCHULA (10 cases), LAMJUNG (7 cases), OKHALDHUNGA (7 cases) and CHITAWAN (6 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from DADELDHURA (14 cases), BAITADI (10 cases), BARDIYA (3 cases), DOTI (2 cases) and JHAPA (2 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (39 cases), SINDHUPALCHOK (22 cases), KATHMANDU (9 cases), LALITPUR (7 cases) and RASUWA (5 cases).
