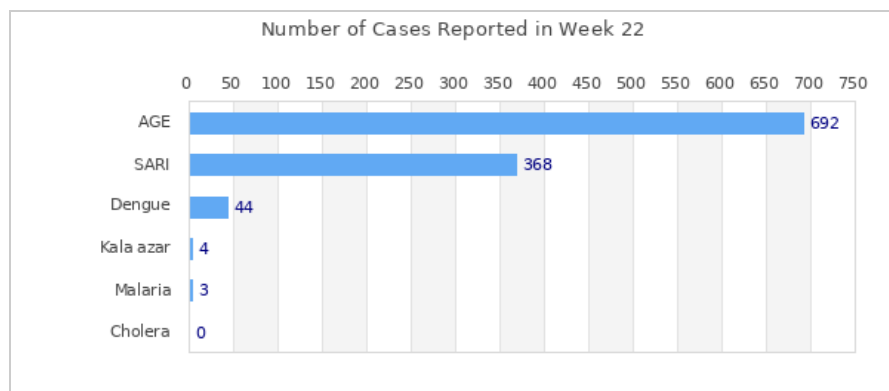




Highlights

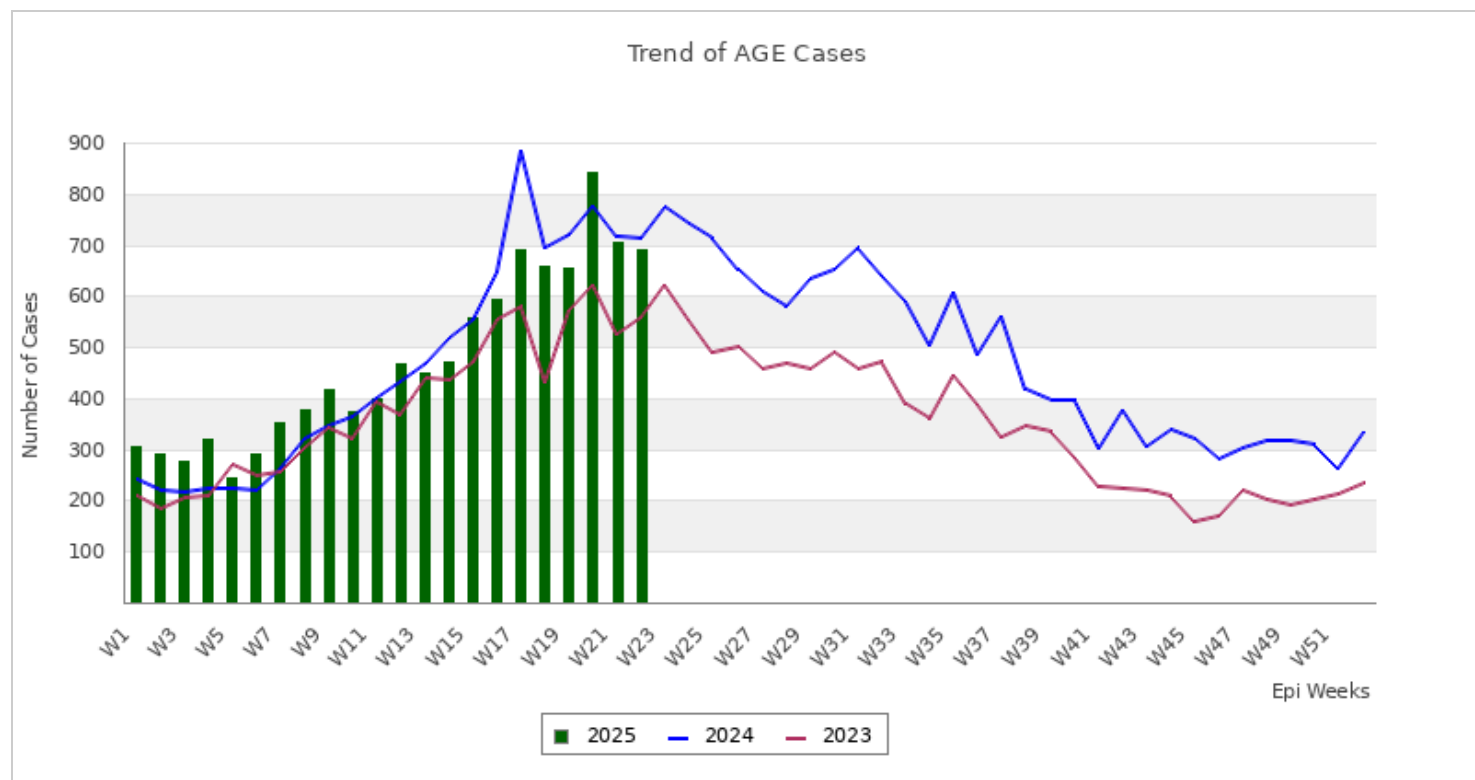
Among the reported diseases, **AGE** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 22 with **692 reported cases**.

Overall reporting rate of Week 22 is **98.5%** with **132 out of 134** sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.

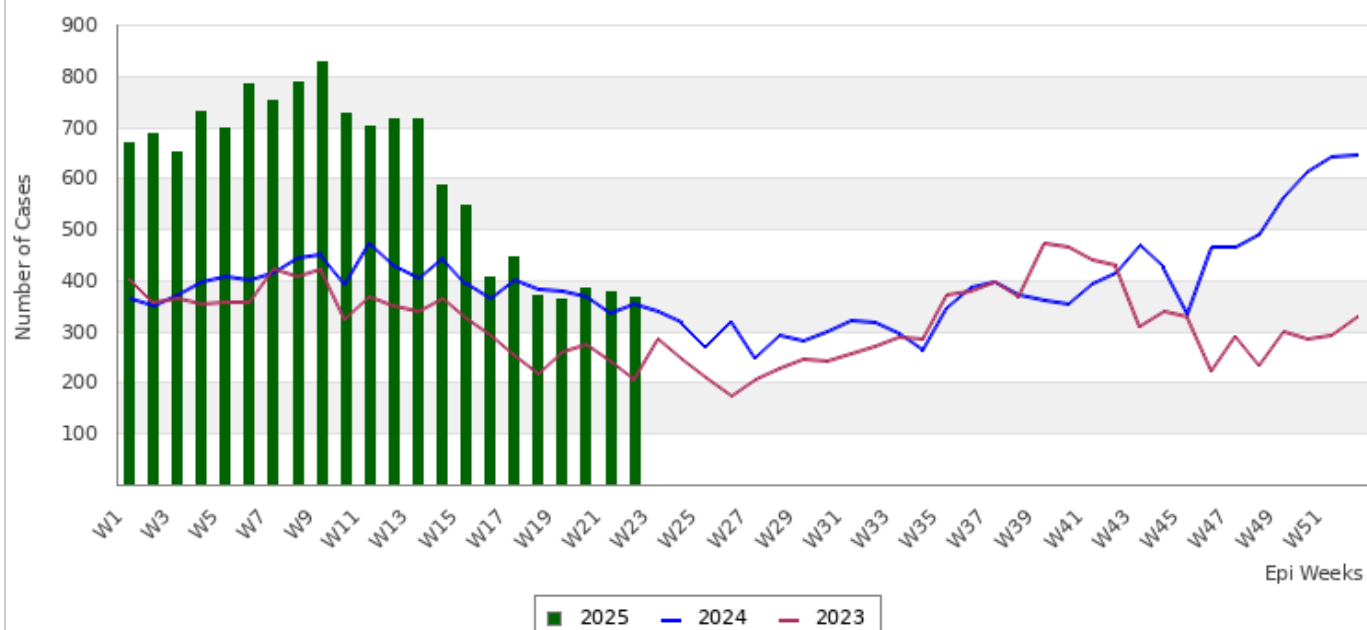


This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provinces of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

Summary Observation (including probable and suspect cases)

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (95 cases), PARSA (44 cases), KAILALI (40 cases), RUPANDEHI (36 cases) and BHAKTAPUR (30 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (42 cases), RUPANDEHI (18 cases), BHAKTAPUR (15 cases), UDAYAPUR (15 cases) and SUNSARI (14 cases).

Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from BHAKTAPUR (24 cases), BHOJPUR (5 cases), DOLAKHA (4 cases), RUPANDEHI (3 cases) and ACHHAM (2 cases).

Most of the **Malaria** cases were reported from KASKI (2 cases), KATHMANDU (2 cases), DAILEKH (1 case), CHITAWAN (1 case) and RAUTAHAT (1 case).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KASKI (9 cases), PALPA (6 cases), CHITAWAN (6 cases), JHAPA (6 cases) and KATHMANDU (4 cases).

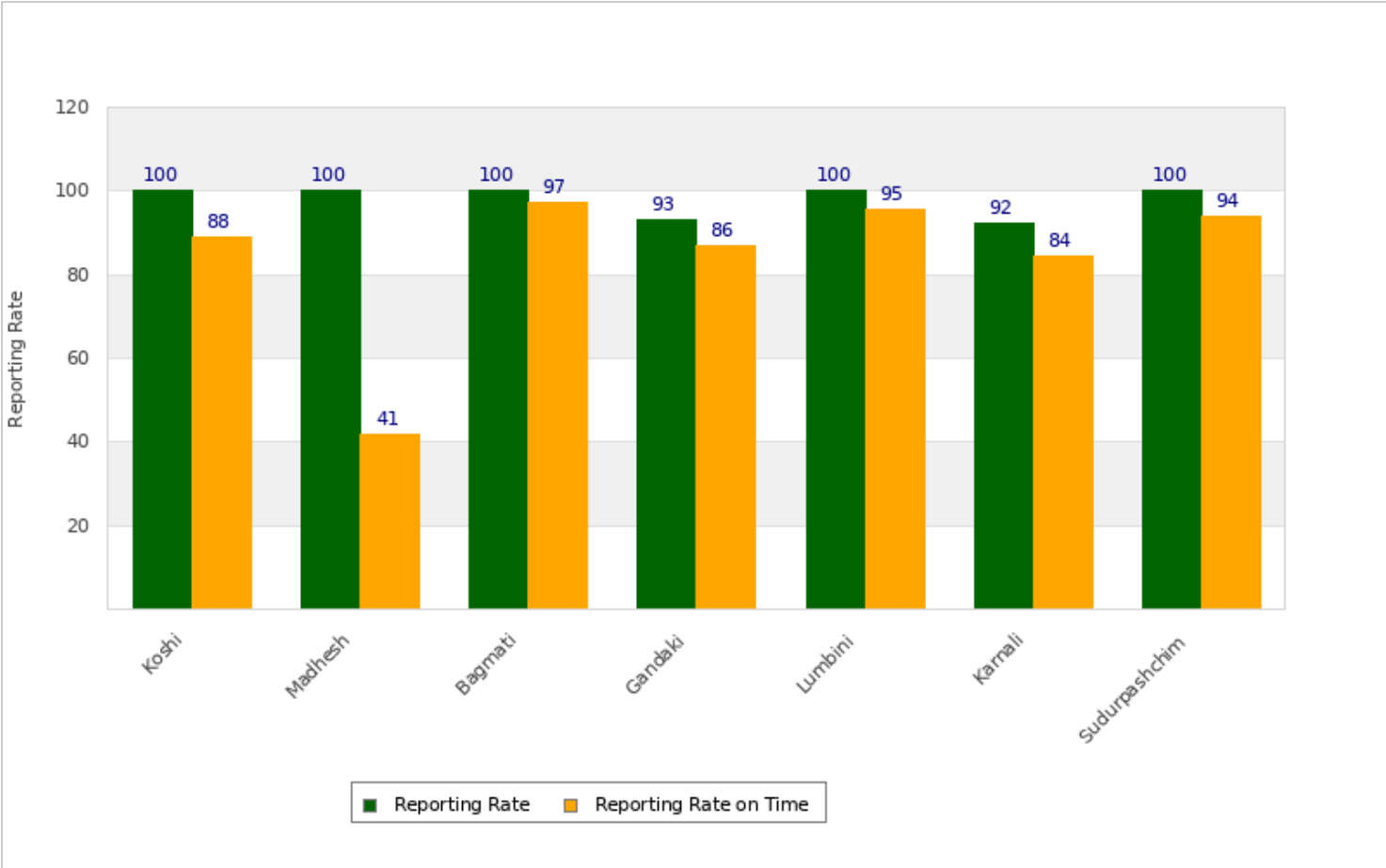
Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from PALPA (1 case), ROLPA (1 case), TANAHU (1 case), BHAKTAPUR (1 case) and TAPLEJUNG (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from ACHHAM (9 cases), DADEL DHURA (7 cases), DANG (7 cases), SANKHUWASABHA (6 cases) and CHITAWAN (5 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KAILALI (28 cases), KATHMANDU (10 cases), DARCHULA (9 cases), DADELDHURA (8 cases) and SARLAHI (8 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from SINDHUPALCHOK (44 cases), BHAKTAPUR (32 cases), KAILALI (23 cases), PARBAT (18 cases) and BAITADI (17 cases).
