



Highlights

Among the reported diseases, **AGE** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 24 with **829 reported cases.**


Overall reporting rate of Week 24 is 97.8% with 131 out of 134 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provices of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

Summary Observation (including probable and suspect cases)

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (107 cases), LALITPUR (60 cases), BHAKTAPUR (55 cases), PARSA (49 cases) and KAVREPALANCHOK (37 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (32 cases), JHAPA (20 cases), MORANG (18 cases), BAITADI (17 cases) and PANCHTHAR (14 cases).

Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from BHAKTAPUR (37 cases), DOLAKHA (4 cases), RUPANDEHI (3 cases), BHOJPUR (2 cases) and KHOTANG (2 cases).

Most of the **Malaria** cases were reported from ACHHAM (1 case), DOTI (1 case), KALIKOT (1 case), BARDIYA (1 case) and KATHMANDU (1 case).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from LAMJUNG (11 cases), KATHMANDU (9 cases), PALPA (8 cases), JHAPA (7 cases) and SANKHUWASABHA (6 cases).


Kala azar case(s) were reported from KAILALI (1 case) and RAUTAHAT (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from SANKHUWASABHA (12 cases), ACHHAM (7 cases), CHITAWAN (6 cases), RUPANDEHI (5 cases) and LAMJUNG (5 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KAILALI (39 cases), KATHMANDU (11 cases), DARCHULA (10 cases), PALPA (9 cases) and PARSA (9 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from BAITADI (47 cases), KAILALI (46 cases), SINDHUPALCHOK (30 cases), ACHHAM (24 cases) and BHAKTAPUR (21 cases).
