
Highlights

Among the reported diseases, **AGE** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 32 with **622** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 32 is **97.4%** with 114 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.


1003584 cases of Corona Virus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991553 cases have been recovered so far.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (87 cases), LALITPUR (45 cases), BHAKTAPUR (38 cases), PARSA (26 cases) and DANG (25 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from BAJURA (20 cases), MORANG (19 cases), RUPANDEHI (18 cases), KASKI (18 cases) and SUNSARI (17 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KASKI (80 cases), PARBAT (43 cases), KATHMANDU (37 cases), TANAHU (26 cases) and LALITPUR (20 cases).

Malaria Vivax case(s) were reported from KATHMANDU (1 case).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KAILALI (1 case), BAITADI (1 case), RUKUM WEST (1 case), SARLAHI (1 case) and OKHALDHUNGA (1 case).


Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from LALITPUR (11 cases), OKHALDHUNGA (5 cases), KATHMANDU (4 cases), KAVREPALANCHOK (2 cases) and RAUTAHAT (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from BHOJPUR (20 cases), ACHHAM (19 cases), DANG (12 cases), PALPA (12 cases) and SYANGJA (12 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from PARSA (10 cases), JHAPA (7 cases), BAJURA (6 cases), MAHOTTARI (6 cases) and SUNSARI (6 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (27 cases), BAITADI (15 cases), LALITPUR (11 cases), SINDHUPALCHOK (11 cases) and RUKUM WEST (8 cases).
