
#### EWARS Weekly Bulletin Week 35, 2024 9th September 2024

### **Highlights**

Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 35 with **1056** reported cases.

Overall reporting rate of Week 35 is **99.1%** with 116 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.


1003593 cases of Corona Virus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991553 cases have been recovered so far.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (54 cases), LALITPUR (37 cases), PARSA (36 cases), DARCHULA (32 cases) and KAILALI (24 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (27 cases), MORANG (25 cases), KAILALI (21 cases), KASKI (17 cases) and SUNSARI (16 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KASKI (224 cases), PARBAT (116 cases), KATHMANDU (95 cases), TANAHU (74 cases) and GORKHA (56 cases).

Most of the **Malaria Vivax** cases were reported from KAILALI (2 cases), ACHHAM (1 case), DADELDHURA (1 case), SURKHET (1 case) and DAILEKH (1 case).

Malaria Falciparum case(s) were reported from KANCHANPUR (1 case).


Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KAILALI (5 cases), RAUTAHAT (2 cases), SURKHET (1 case), BAGLUNG (1 case) and KATHMANDU (1 case).

Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (4 cases), OKHALDHUNGA (4 cases), LALITPUR (3 cases), RUPANDEHI (3 cases) and BANKE (2 cases).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from KAILALI (27 cases), DANG (27 cases), SANKHUWASABHA (26 cases), GORKHA (25 cases) and ACHHAM (24 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from PARSA (15 cases), ROLPA (14 cases), PALPA (10 cases), SUNSARI (10 cases) and JHAPA (9 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (32 cases), BAITADI (21 cases), LALITPUR (13 cases), BAJURA (11 cases) and RUKUM WEST (9 cases).
