


Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 40 with **2332** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 40 is **94.0%** with 110 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus the number of reporting sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 117.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (32 cases), PARSA (30 cases), RUKUM WEST (26 cases), MAKWANPUR (19 cases) and MYAGDI (17 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (29 cases), SUNSARI (29 cases), KAILALI (18 cases), KASKI (18 cases) and MORANG (15 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (502 cases), KASKI (397 cases), TANAHU (226 cases), LALITPUR (157 cases) and PARBAT (156 cases).

Malaria Falciparum case(s) were reported from RUPANDEHI (1 case) and SYANGJA (1 case).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from RUKUM WEST (2 cases), BAJURA (1 case), DANG (1 case) and NAWALPARASIEAST (1 case).


Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (3 cases), DOLAKHA (2 cases) and PALPA (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from TANAHU (67 cases), DANG (44 cases), KAILALI (42 cases), ACHHAM (38 cases) and ROLPA (21 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from DARCHULA (11 cases), RUKUM WEST (10 cases), KATHMANDU (7 cases), BARA (7 cases) and JHAPA (5 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (48 cases), BAITADI (24 cases), BAJURA (17 cases), RUKUM WEST (15 cases) and KAILALI (13 cases).
