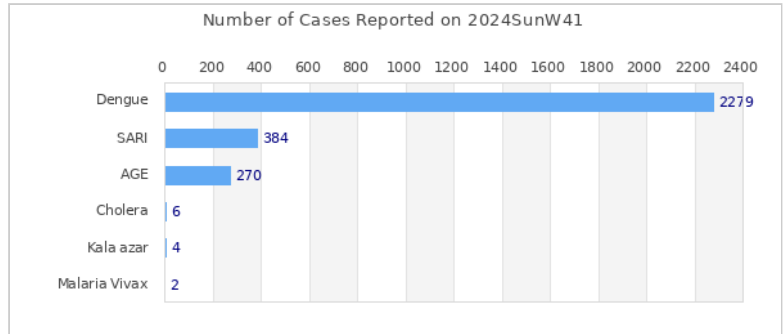




Highlights

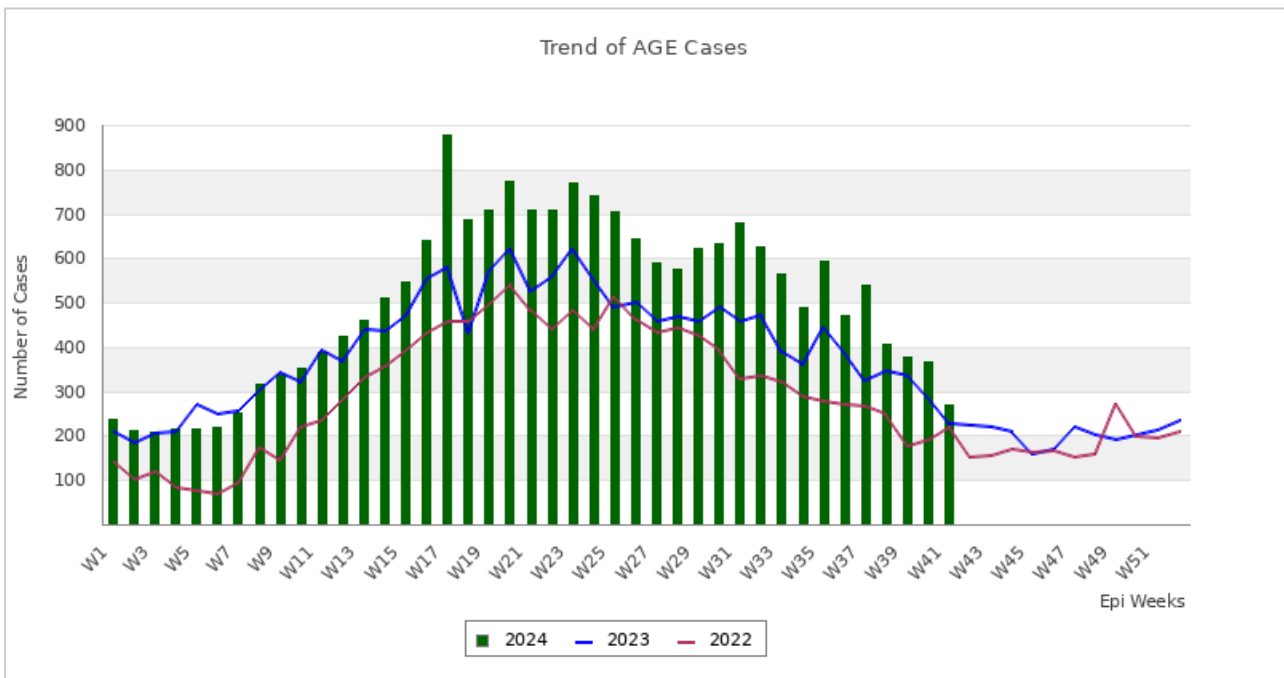
Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 41 with **2279** reported cases.

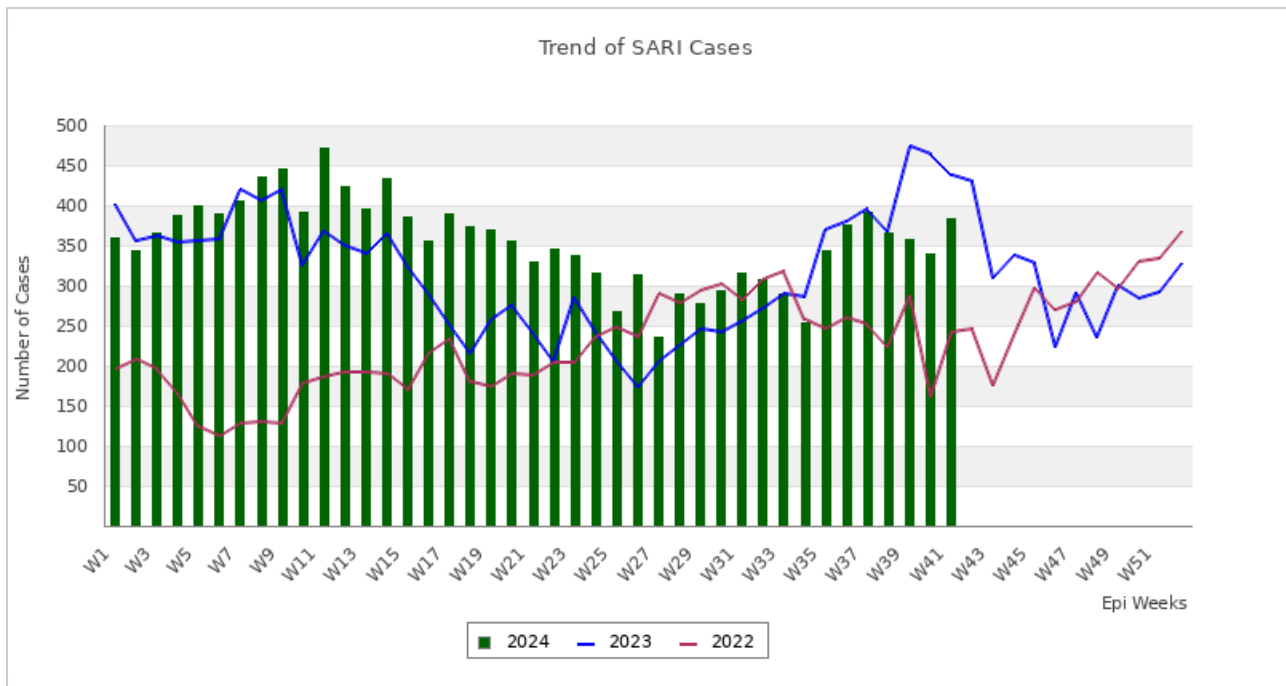
Overall reporting rate of Week 41 is **94.0%** with 110 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus the number of reporting sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 117.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (21 cases), SUNSARI (20 cases), GULMI (16 cases), PARSA (15 cases) and MAKWANPUR (14 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (42 cases), BAJURA (31 cases), MORANG (26 cases), KASKI (25 cases) and LALITPUR (17 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (435 cases), KASKI (264 cases), BAGLUNG (224 cases), BHAKTAPUR (184 cases) and LALITPUR (162 cases).

Malaria Vivax case(s) were reported from KANCHANPUR (1 case) and ACHHAM (1 case).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from BAJURA (1 case), JAJARKOT (1 case), DHANUSA (1 case) and SIRAHA (1 case).

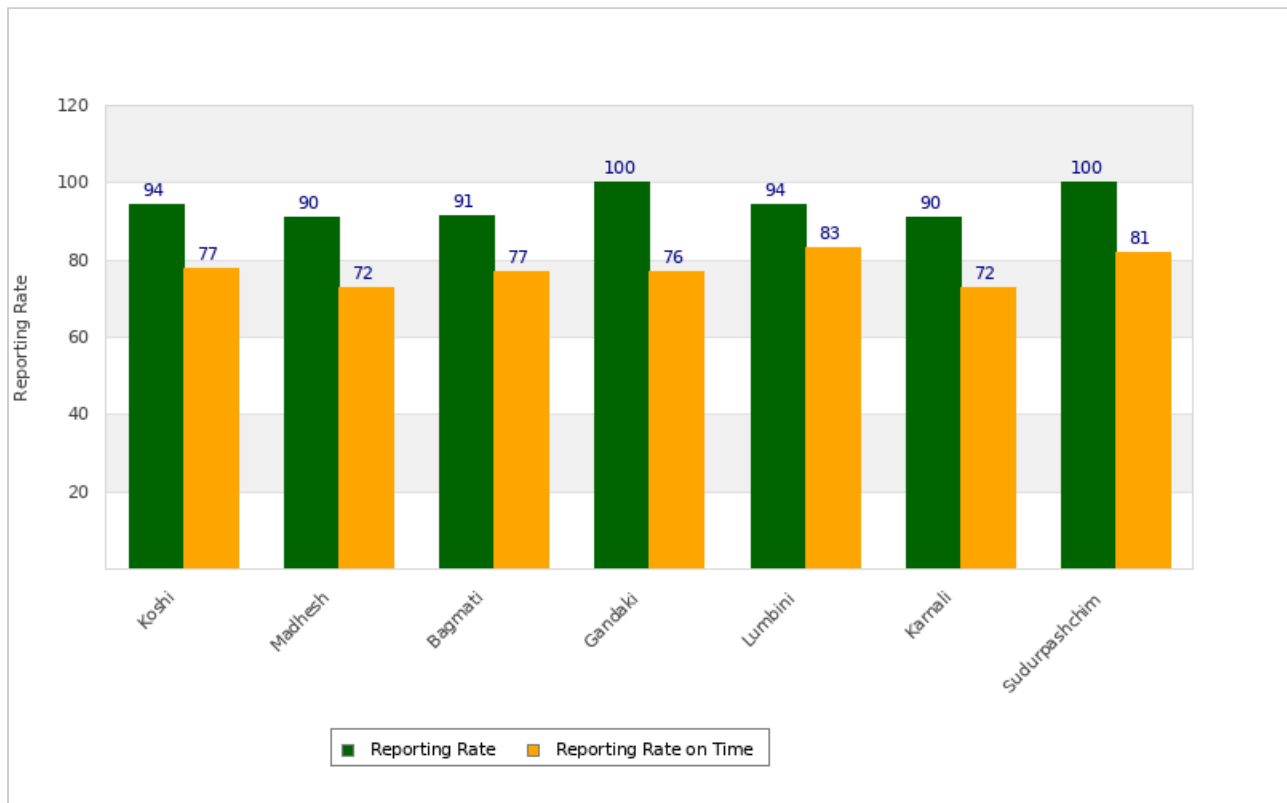
Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (4 cases), ACHHAM (1 case) and OKHALDHUNGA (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DANG (37 cases), DHADING (19 cases), SYANGJA (18 cases), PALPA (17 cases) and GORKHA (17 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from DADEL DHURA (9 cases), DARCHULA (8 cases), PALPA (8 cases), KAILALI (7 cases) and PARSA (7 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (39 cases), KAILALI (12 cases), RASUWA (7 cases), KANCHANPUR (5 cases) and LALITPUR (4 cases).
