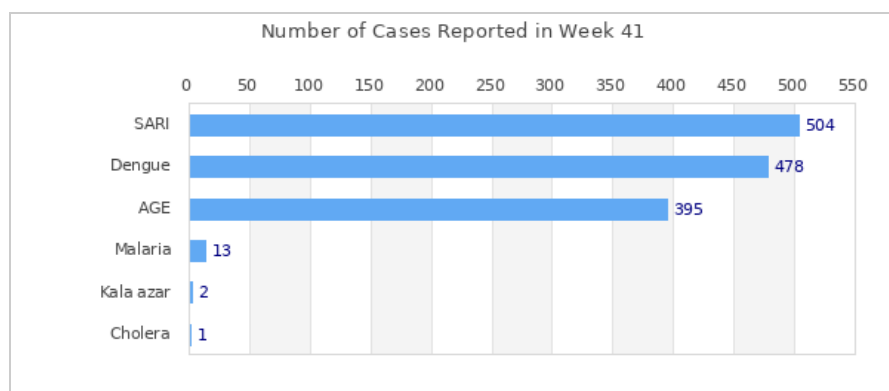




Highlights

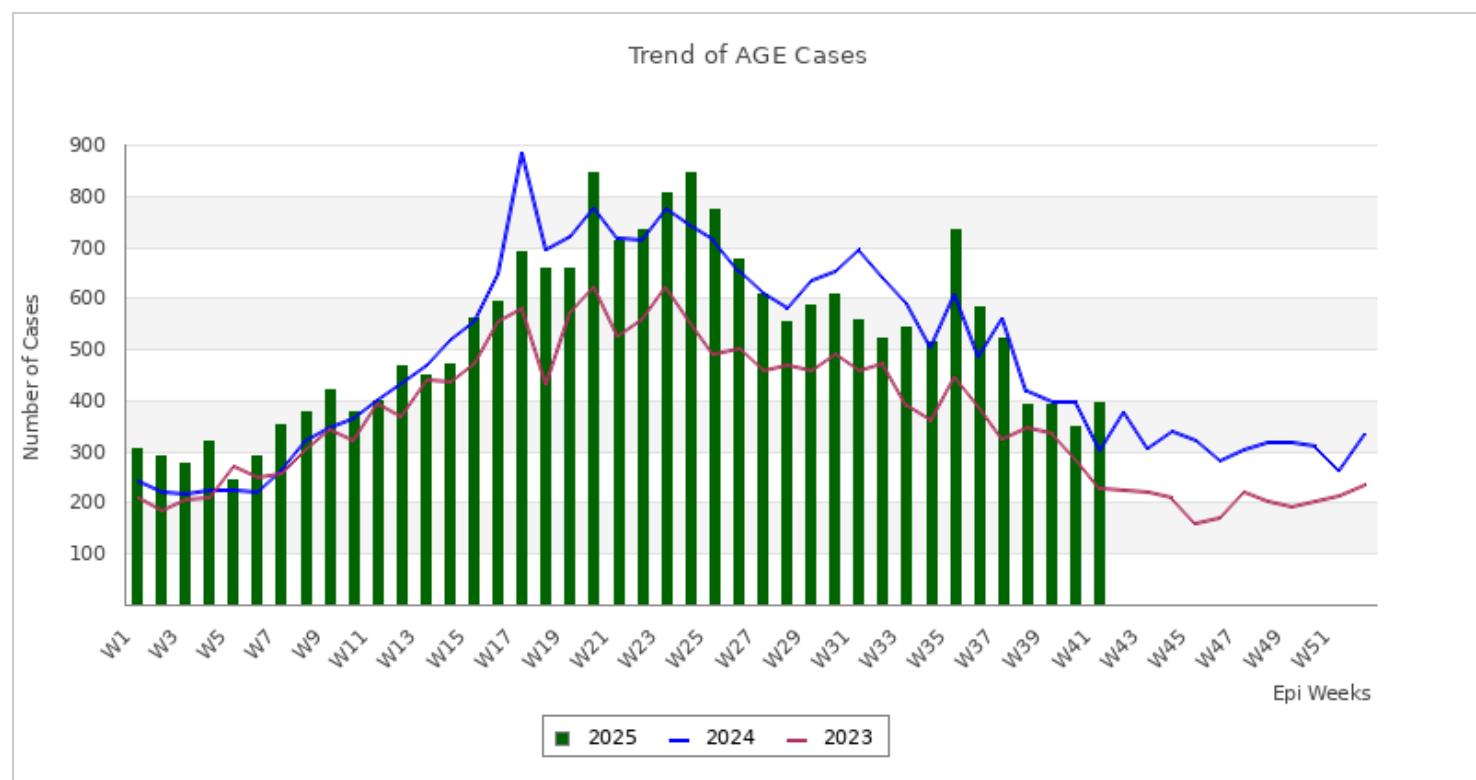
Among the reported diseases, **SARI** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 41 with **504 reported cases**.

Overall reporting rate of Week 41 is **94.8%** with **127 out of 134** sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.

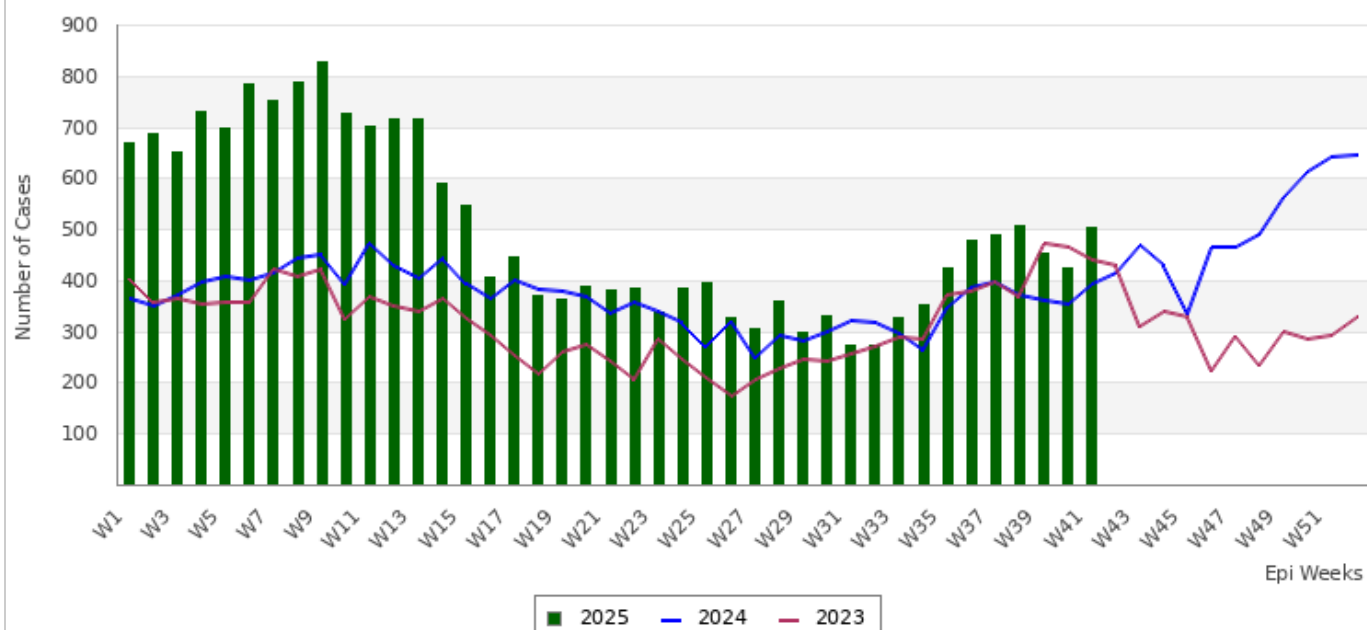


This bulletin includes data since January 2023 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provinces of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites have increased. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

Summary Observation (including probable and suspect cases)

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from PARSA (38 cases), KATHMANDU (33 cases), BHAKTAPUR (26 cases), BARA (18 cases) and KAILALI (15 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (43 cases), KAILALI (21 cases), KAPILBASTU (21 cases), MORANG (21 cases) and PARBAT (19 cases).

Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from BHAKTAPUR (6 cases), BHOJPUR (3 cases), DOLAKHA (2 cases), SINDHUPALCHOK (1 case) and PARSA (1 case).

Most of the **Malaria** cases were reported from RUPANDEHI (3 cases), SURKHET (2 cases), PALPA (2 cases), GULMI (2 cases) and SUNSARI (1 case).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from BAGLUNG (108 cases), KATHMANDU (89 cases), SURKHET (51 cases), DANG (26 cases) and LALITPUR (12 cases).

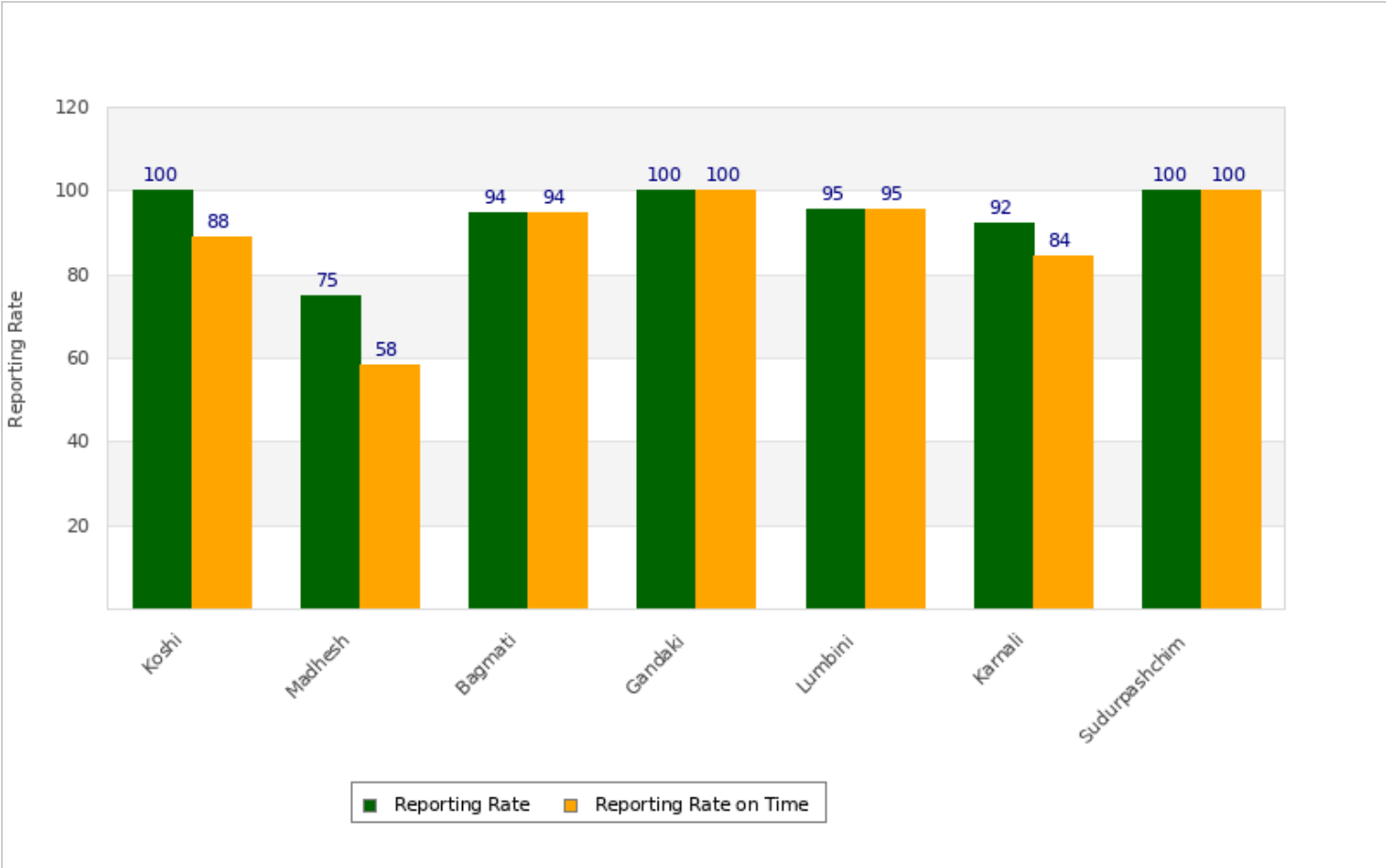
Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KANCHANPUR (1 case), KAILALI (1 case) and MAKWANPUR (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DANG (93 cases), ROLPA (32 cases), BAJURA (29 cases), SYANGJA (26 cases) and ACHHAM (24 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KAILALI (28 cases), KANCHANPUR (9 cases), PALPA (8 cases), KASKI (7 cases) and BARA (6 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from KAILALI (53 cases), PARBAT (41 cases), DAILEKH (31 cases), SINDHUPALCHOK (29 cases) and ACHHAM (23 cases).
