


Highlights

Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 42 with **2602** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 42 is **97.4%** with 114 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus the number of reporting sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 117.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (29 cases), PARSA (22 cases), BARA (19 cases), KAILALI (16 cases) and DAILEKH (13 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (41 cases), JUMLA (25 cases), MORANG (23 cases), KAILALI (19 cases) and KASKI (18 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (578 cases), KASKI (233 cases), BAGLUNG (225 cases), BHAKTAPUR (188 cases) and TANAHU (174 cases).

Malaria Vivax case(s) were reported from ACHHAM (1 case) and BAJURA (1 case).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KALIKOT (2 cases), RAMECHHAP (1 case), NUWAKOT (1 case), MAHOTTARI (1 case) and DHANUSA (1 case).


Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from PALPA (3 cases), BANKE (1 case) and KAVREPALANCHOK (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from BARDIYA (28 cases), DANG (27 cases), CHITAWAN (27 cases), DHADING (22 cases) and GORKHA (21 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from OKHALDHUNGA (13 cases), JHAPA (10 cases), KATHMANDU (7 cases), BARA (7 cases) and SARLAHI (7 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (37 cases), BAITADI (24 cases), KAILALI (14 cases), BAJURA (11 cases) and BHAKTAPUR (7 cases).
