


Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 43 with **2265** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 43 is **95.7%** with 112 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus the number of reporting sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 117.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (17 cases), KAILALI (15 cases), PALPA (12 cases), BHAKTAPUR (12 cases) and BAJURA (11 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (41 cases), SUNSARI (30 cases), MORANG (28 cases), RUPANDEHI (23 cases) and KAILALI (18 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (656 cases), KASKI (195 cases), LALITPUR (155 cases), BAGLUNG (144 cases) and BHAKTAPUR (125 cases).

Malaria Vivax case(s) were reported from ACHHAM (2 cases) and BANKE (1 case).

Malaria Falciparum case(s) were reported from ACHHAM (1 case) and BAGLUNG (1 case).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from PYUTHAN (2 cases), JAJARKOT (1 case), KASKI (1 case), SINDHULI (1 case) and MAHOTTARI (1 case).


Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from BHAKTAPUR (5 cases), KATHMANDU (3 cases), PALPA (1 case) and OKHALDHUNGA (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from BARDIYA (45 cases), KAILALI (28 cases), ACHHAM (28 cases), DANG (27 cases) and DHADING (21 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from BARDIYA (16 cases), PARSA (10 cases), BARA (9 cases), PALPA (6 cases) and JHAPA (6 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (60 cases), KAILALI (33 cases), BAITADI (22 cases), BAJURA (15 cases) and RUKUM WEST (14 cases).
