


Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 44 with **1555** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 44 is **94.0%** with 110 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus the number of reporting sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 117.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from ARGHAKHANCHI (56 cases), PALPA (34 cases), PARSA (23 cases), SUNSARI (13 cases) and KAILALI (12 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (55 cases), SUNSARI (30 cases), MORANG (22 cases), RUPANDEHI (20 cases) and KASKI (15 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (417 cases), BHAKTAPUR (183 cases), KASKI (146 cases), TANAHU (100 cases) and LALITPUR (93 cases).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KAlLALI (1 case), KALIKOT (1 case) and ARGHAKHANCHI (1 case).


Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from BHAKTAPUR (6 cases), KATHMANDU (4 cases) and PALPA (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DANG (26 cases), KAILALI (25 cases), RUPANDEHI (15 cases), OKHALDHUNGA (15 cases) and CHITAWAN (13 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from PARSA (15 cases), BARA (11 cases), BAJHANG (7 cases), MAHOTTARI (6 cases) and SUNSARI (6 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from BAITADI (28 cases), KAILALI (19 cases), ACHHAM (18 cases), BAJURA (10 cases) and RUKUM WEST (10 cases).
