


Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 45 with **1734** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 45 is **93.2%** with 109 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus the number of reporting sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 117.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KAILALI (28 cases), PARSA (21 cases), PALPA (19 cases), RUPANDEHI (18 cases) and KATHMANDU (16 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (35 cases), SUNSARI (21 cases), RUPANDEHI (20 cases), KAILALI (19 cases) and KASKI (17 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (440 cases), BAGLUNG (239 cases), TANAHU (123 cases), KASKI (123 cases) and BHAKTAPUR (106 cases).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from PALPA (2 cases), KAILALI (1 case), SIRAHA (1 case), KHOTANG (1 case) and OKHALDHUNGA (1 case).


Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (2 cases), BHAKTAPUR (1 case) and DOLAKHA (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from KAILALI (34 cases), DANG (32 cases), RUPANDEHI (14 cases), DHADING (14 cases) and SYANGJA (11 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from PARSA (9 cases), KAILALI (8 cases), BARA (8 cases), JHAPA (6 cases) and SARLAHI (5 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from KAILALI (21 cases), ACHHAM (21 cases), RUKUM WEST (15 cases), BAITADI (11 cases) and SINDHUPALCHOK (9 cases).
