


Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **Dengue** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 47 with **874** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 47 is **93.2%** with 109 out of 117 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus the number of reporting sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from PARSA (29 cases), SUNSARI (14 cases), KAILALI (13 cases), PALPA (13 cases) and KATHMANDU (13 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (48 cases), KASKI (28 cases), SUNSARI (27 cases), MORANG (27 cases) and RUPANDEHI (18 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (239 cases), KASKI (69 cases), BHAKTAPUR (57 cases), LALITPUR (49 cases) and BAGLUNG (40 cases).

Malaria Vivax case(s) were reported from ACHHAM (1 case).


Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KAILALI (2 cases), KALIKOT (1 case), SINDHULI (1 case), SARLAHI (1 case) and DHANUSA (1 case).

Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from RUPANDEHI (2 cases), BHAKTAPUR (2 cases) and SYANGJA (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DANG (16 cases), BANKE (14 cases), CHITAWAN (13 cases), BARDIYA (12 cases) and KAILALI (9 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KAILALI (15 cases), SUNSARI (7 cases), RUPANDEHI (5 cases), PARSA (5 cases) and BARA (5 cases).

Most of the Influenza Like Illness cases were reported from ACHHAM (35 cases), KAILALI (33 cases), BAITADI (27 cases), BAJURA (18 cases) and RUKUM WEST (13 cases).
