


## Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **SARI** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 8 with **758 (probable/suspect/confirm)** reported cases.


Overall reporting rate of Week 8 is **96.3%** with 129 out of 134 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provices of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

**Summary Observation** 

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (36 cases), PARSA (30 cases), KAILALI (12 cases), KASKI (12 cases) and OKHALDHUNGA (11 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (94 cases), RUPANDEHI (52 cases), MORANG (42 cases), SUNSARI (41 cases) and KAILALI (37 cases).

Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from KHOTANG (2 cases), ACHHAM (1 case) and PARBAT (1 case).

Malaria case(s) were reported from KAILALI (1 case).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (5 cases), ARGHAKHANCHI (4 cases), CHITAWAN (4 cases), SUNSARI (4 cases) and PANCHTHAR (4 cases).


Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from KALIKOT (3 cases), KATHMANDU (2 cases), RUPANDEHI (1 case), MAKWANPUR (1 case) and DHANUSA (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DOTI (15 cases), KANCHANPUR (10 cases), DARCHULA (9 cases), LALITPUR (8 cases) and DANG (7 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (8 cases), OKHALDHUNGA (7 cases), BARA (6 cases), MORANG (6 cases) and JHAPA (6 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from KAILALI (123 cases), SOLUKHUMBU (67 cases), BHAKTAPUR (61 cases), SINDHUPALCHOK (56 cases) and BAITADI (41 cases).
