
Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal ^{22th} Epidemiological Week, 2023 Sunday, 11th June, 2023

Highlights


- 1003353 cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991312 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, AGE is the leading cause of morbidity in week 22.



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)


- 534 cases of AGE were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu (51 case), Parsa (35 case), Tanahun (28 case), Rukum West (27 case), Sunsari (25 case), Bara (22 case), Rupandehi, Kaski & Chitawan (21 case from each district), Palpa, Gulmi & Lalitpur (16 case from each district).
- 438 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2022.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

191 cases of SARI were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu (12 case), Rupandehi and Kailali (10 case from each district), Chitawan (9 case), Sunsari, Parsa, Pyuthan and Kaski (8 case from each district), Makawanpur and Parbat (7 case from each district), Lalitpur and Morang (6 case from each district).

204 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2022.



3. Malaria

- One Case of malaria were reported this week. Of which, the case of malaria was of <u>falciparum</u> and was reported from Kailali.
- Four cases of malaria <u>vivax</u> were reported this week in 2022.

4. Kala-azar

- Three cases of kala-azar were reported this week. They were from Sindhuli, Doti & Dolpa.
- Six cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2022.

5. Cholera

- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week.
- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week in 2022.

6. Dengue

- 18 cases of dengue were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Darchula and Kaski (3 case from each district), Morang and Nuwakot (2 case from each district) and single cases were reported from 8 districts including Kailali, Tanahun and Lamjung.
- Nine cases of dengue were reported this week in 2022.

Other diseases


Scrub typhus

- 47 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. Most of the cases were reported from Rukum West (6 case), Kailali and Gulmi (5 case from each district), Darchula and Palpa (4 case from each district). Arghakhanchi, Dang and Nawalparasi West (3 case from each district), Chitwan and Rupandehi (2 case from each district). Ten single cases were reported from ten districts including Parsa and Sunsari.
- 34 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2022.


