
Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal ^{23th} Epidemiological Week, 2023 Sunday, 18th June, 2023

Highlights


- 1003360 cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991321 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, AGE is the leading cause of morbidity in week 23.



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.


1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 592 cases of AGE were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu and RukumWest (50 case from each district), Sunsari and Parsa (40 case from each district), Lalitpur (21 case), Kaski and Bara (20 case from each district), Rupandehi & Chitawan (19 case from each district), Kapilvastu and Tanahun (18 case from each district).
- 483 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2022.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 227 cases of SARI were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Rupandehi (20 case), Morang (16 case), Kaski (15 case), Kailali and Sunsari (12 case from each district), Jhapa (11 case), Palpa, Kathmandu and Chitwan (10 case from each district).
- 204 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2022.



3. Malaria

- Three Cases of malaria were reported this week. Of which, two cases of malaria were of vivax and reported from Kailali and Kanchanpur and one malaria falciparum case was from Chitwan.
- Two cases of malaria <u>vivax</u> were reported this week in 2022.

4. Kala-azar

- Two cases of kala-azar were reported this week. They were from Baitadi and Kalikot.
- 10 cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2022.

5. Cholera

- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week.
- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week in 2022.

6. Dengue

- 36 cases of dengue were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Sunsari (7 case), Sankhuwasabha (6 case), Makawanpur and Achham (3 case from each district), Kathmandu, Rupandehi and Dang (2 case from each district) and single cases were reported from 11 districts including Dhading and Morang.
- Seven cases of dengue were reported this week in 2022.


Other diseases Scrub typhus

- 27 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. Most of the cases were reported from Dhading, Gorkha and Dadeldhura (3 case from each district), Gulmi, Dang, Rupandehi, Darchul, Palpa and Syangja (2 case from each district). Six districts were with single case including Baglung and Parsa.
- 42 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2022.


