

# Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal


## 24<sup>rd</sup> Epidemiological Week

### 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2021

#### Highlights

- 633679 cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 584334 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI) is the leading cause of morbidity in week 24.


#### Number of cases reported for each disease this week



**Note:** This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.


### 1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE) and Cholera

- 53 cases of AGE are reported this week. Majority of these cases are from Okhaldhunga and Jumla (5 cases from each districts), Taplejung and Mahottari (4 Cases from each districts), Dhanusa and Kathmandu (3 Cases from each districts).
- 106 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2020.



## 2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 54 cases of SARI are reported this week. Majority of these cases are from Jhapa (7 cases), Saptari (5 cases), Rupandehi (4 cases).
- 72 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2020.



## 3. Malaria

- Two case of malaria were reported this week and one case each were reported from Achham and Baitadi districts.
- Two case of malaria were reported this week in 2020.

## 4. Dengue

- One case of dengue was reported this week and which was reported from Kanchanpur district
- Five cases of dengue were reported this week in 2020.

## 5. Kala-azar

- Two case of kala-azar were reported this week and which was reported from kalikot district.
- Three cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2020.

## Other diseases


### Scrub typhus

- Five cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. The majority of the cases were reported from Palpa ( 2 cases)and Morang, Dadeldhura and Bajhang (1 cases from each district)
- Eight cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2020.
