
Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal ^{25th} Epidemiological Week, 2023 Sunday, 2nd July, 2023

Highlights


- 1003368 cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991321 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, AGE is the leading cause of morbidity in week 25.



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.


1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 446 cases of AGE were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu (62 case), Parsa (31 case), Rupandehi (19 case), Kaski (18 case), and Lalitpur (17 case).
- 513 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2022.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 193 cases of SARI were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu (13 case), Morang (10 case), Chitwan and Kailali (9 case from each district), Tanahun, Syangja and Rupandehi (7 case from each district).
- 247 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2022.



3. Malaria

- Zero case of malaria were reported this week.
- Three cases of malaria (vivax) were reported this week in 2022.

4. Kala-azar

- Two cases of kala-azar were reported this week. Of them, they were from Arghakhanchi and Kathmandu.
- Seven cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2022.

5. Cholera

- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week.
- Seven case of Cholera was reported this week in 2022.

6. Dengue

- 125 cases of dengue were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Sunsari (37 case), Dhading (34 case), Sankhuwasabha (6 case), Nuwakot and Palpa (5 case from each district) and Morang (4 case).
- 41 cases of dengue were reported this week in 2022.


Other diseases Scrub typhus

- 15 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. Most of the cases were reported from Kathmandu (2 case). Single case was reported from 13 districts including Dhading, Bara and Gorkha.
- 30 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2022.


