

# Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal

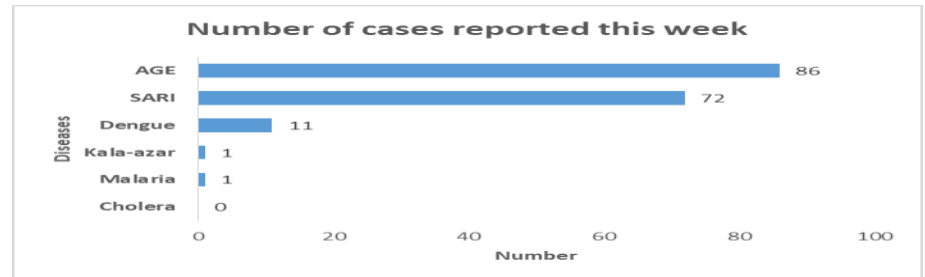
## 27<sup>th</sup> Epidemiological Week

### 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2021

#### Highlights

- 667137 Cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 632074 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE) is the leading cause of morbidity in week 27.

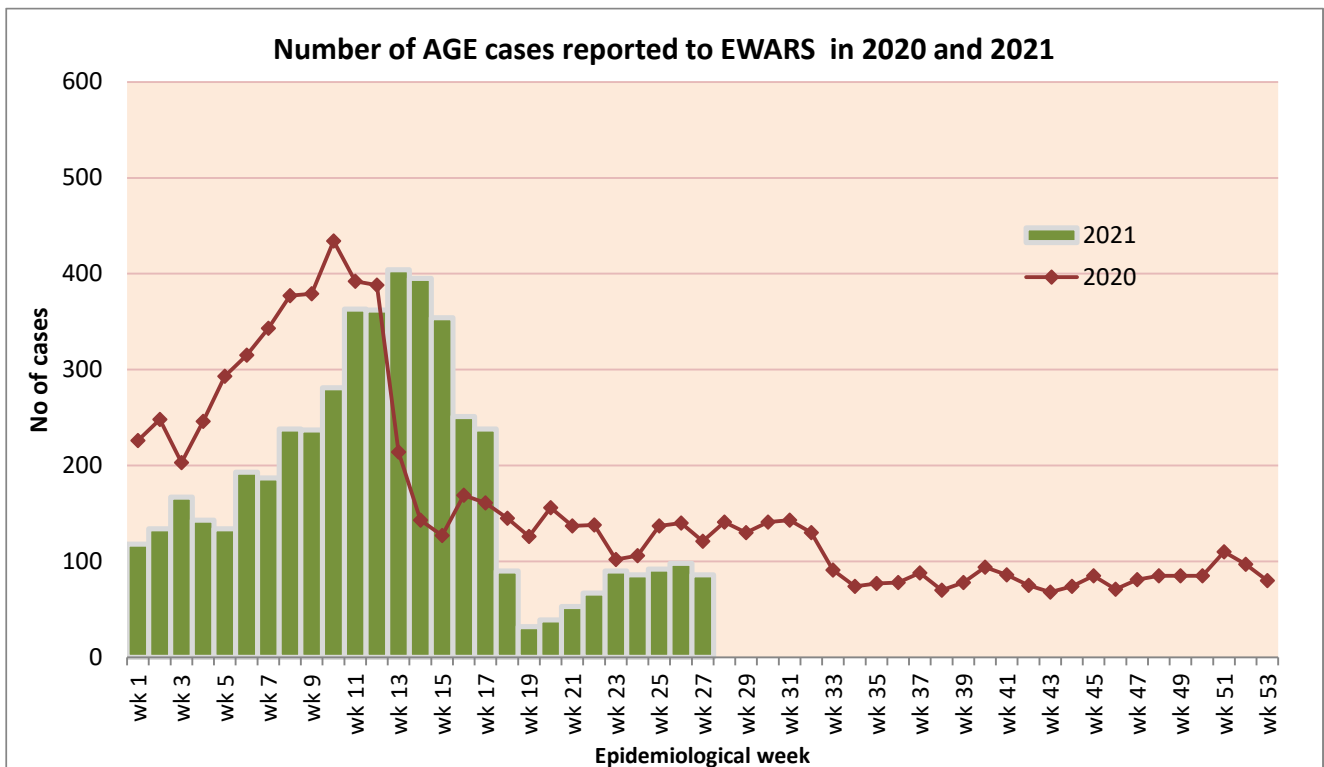
#### Number of cases reported for each disease this week



**Note:** This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

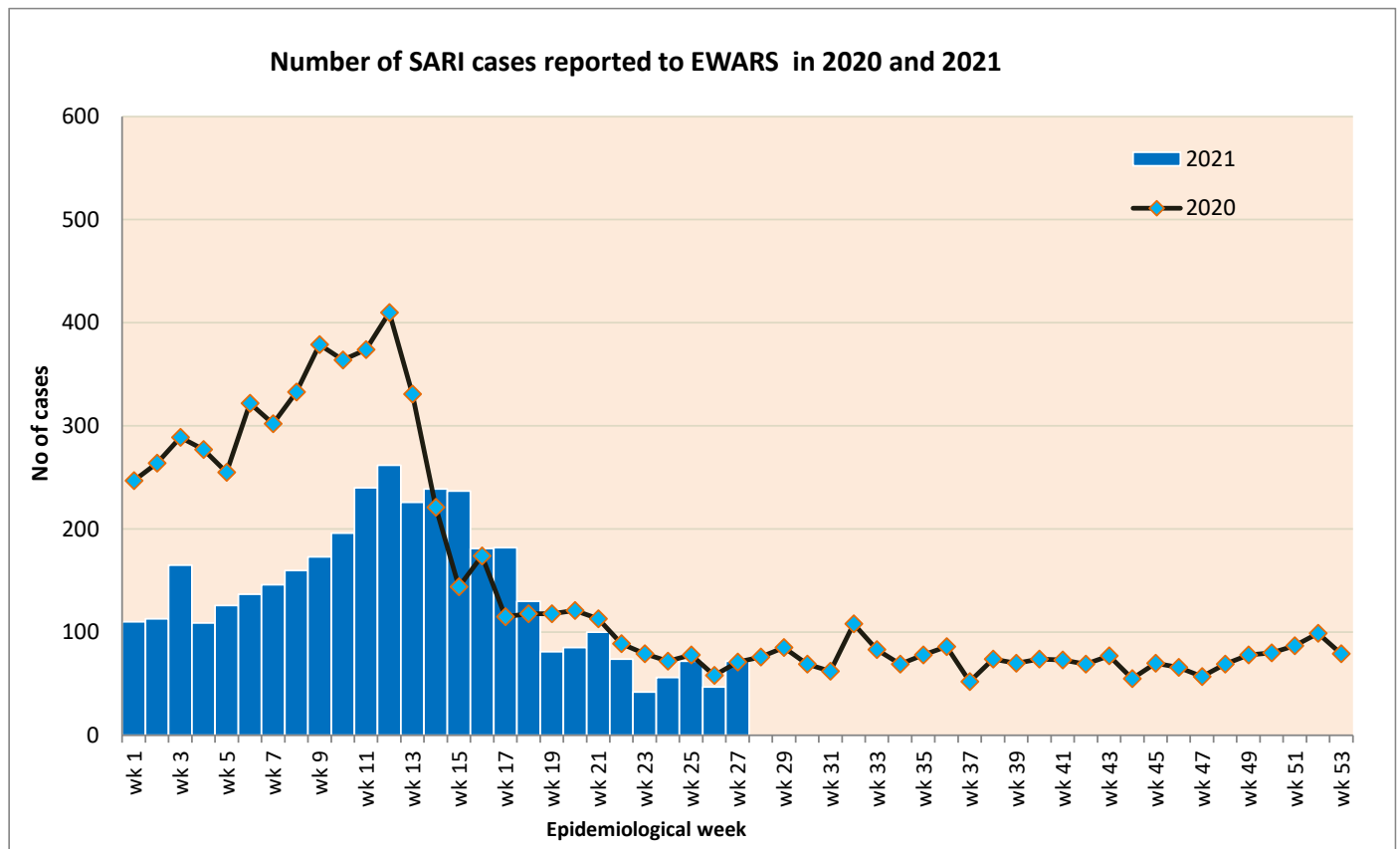
### 1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE) and Cholera

- 86 cases of AGE are reported this week. Majority of these cases are from Jumla (7 cases), Bajura, Dholakha, Pyuthan (6 Cases from each districts), Dhanusa, Kapilbastu (5 Cases from each districts).
- 121 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2020.



## 2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 72 cases of SARI are reported this week. Majority of these cases are from Jhapa (14 cases), Dhankuta (9 cases), Bajhang (5 cases), Surkhet, Rolpa, and morang (4 cases from each districts).
- 71 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2020.



## 3. Malaria

- One case of malaria was reported this week and which was reported from Achham district.
- Five case of malaria were reported this week in 2020.

## 4. Dengue

- 11 case of dengue was reported this week. The majority of the case were reported from Sankhuwasabha (6 Case), Myagdi (3 Case), Nawalparasi East and Khotang (1 cases from each district).
- Seven cases of dengue were reported this week in 2020.

## 5. Kala-azar

- One case of kala-azar was reported this week and which was reported from Sankhuwasabha district.
- Two cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2020.

## Other diseases

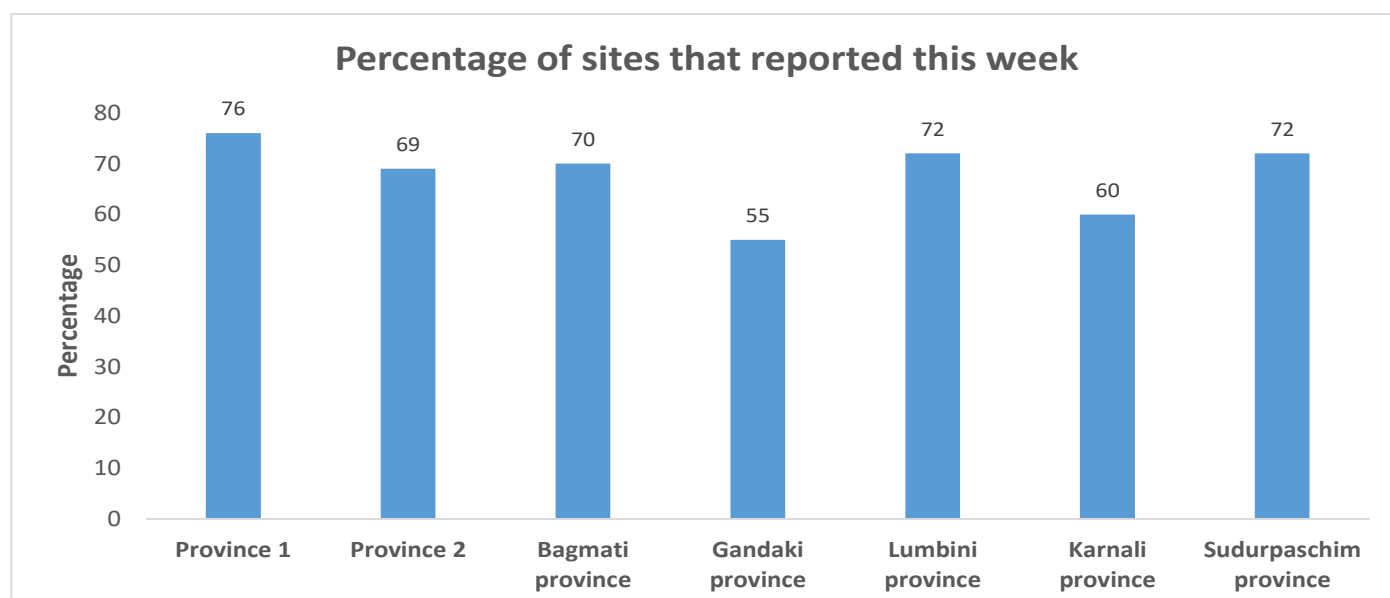
### Scrub typhus

- 18 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. The majority of the cases were reported from Darchula and Palpa (3 cases from each district), Sindhuli and Gulmi (3 cases from each district).
- 13 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2020.
