
Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal ^{27th} Epidemiological Week, 2023 Sunday, 16th July, 2023

Highlights


- 1003371 cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991321 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, AGE is the leading cause of morbidity in week 27.



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.


1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 414 cases of AGE were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu (42 case), Parsa (25 case), Rukum West (21 case), Lalitpur (20 case), Kaski, Kapilvastu, Dhanusha and Bara (13 case from each district).
- 433 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2022.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 197 cases of SARI were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Parsa (13 case), Kaski (12 case), Jumla (10 case), Lalitpur (8 case), Chitwan, Rupandehi, Baitadi, Sunsari, and Morang (7 case from each district).
- 289 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2022.



3. Malaria

- Two case of malaria vivax were reported this week. They were from Kailali and Nawalparasi East.
- Three case of malaria (falciparum) were reported this week in 2022.

4. Kala-azar

- Four cases of kala-azar were reported this week. Of them, single case each from Panchthar, Kavrepalanchwok, Rukum West and Surkhet.
- Four cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2022.

5. Cholera

- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week.
- Two cases of Cholera were reported this week in 2022.

6. Dengue

- 202 cases of dengue were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Sunsari (50 case), Dhading (48 case), Kaski (24 case), Sankhuwasabha (12 case), and Tehrathum (10 case).
- 59 cases of dengue were reported this week in 2022.


Other diseases Scrub typhus

- . 16 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. Most of the cases were reported from Gorkha, Gulmi and Dang (2 case from each district). Ten districts have single case of scrub typhus including Illam and Kathmandu.
- 64 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2022.


