
Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal 45th Epidemiological Week, 2023 Sunday, 19th November, 2023

Highlights


- 1003442 cases of Corona Virus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991350 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, Dengue is the leading cause of morbidity in week 45.



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.


1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 134 cases of AGE were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Sunsari (13 case), Kathmandu and Saptari (9 case from each district), Bara and Rautahat (7 case from each district), Makawanpur and Parsa (6 case from each district), Kapilbastu, Dhanusha and Khotang (5 case from each district).
- 161 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2022.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 268 cases of SARI were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Morang (36 case), Kathmandu (20 case), Salyan (17 case), Rupandehi (16 case), Jumla and Parsa (11 case from each district).
- 298 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2022.



Malaria 3.

- Zero case of Malaria were reported this week.
- Three cases of Malaria were reported this week in 2022.

Kala-azar 4.

- Two cases of Kala-azar were reported this week. They were from Darchula and Kalikot.
- Six cases of Kala-azar were reported this week in 2022.

Cholera 5.

- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week.
- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week in 2022.

Dengue 6.

- 634 cases of Dengue were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kaski (120 case), Kathmandu (83 case), Tanahun (65 case), Baglung (45 case), Bhaktapur (42 case), and Chitawan (40 case).
 - 800 cases of Dengue were reported this week in 2022.


Other diseases **Scrub typhus**

- 63 case of Scrub Typhus were reported this week. Of them, most of the cases were reported from, Kailali (11 case), Banke (6 case), Okhaldhunga (5 case), Bardia (4 case), Darchula, Rupandehi, Chitawan and Morang (3 case from each district).
- 126 cases of Scrub Typhus were reported this week in 2022.


