

Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal

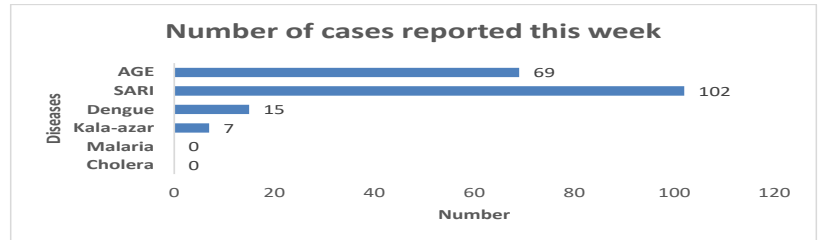
46th Epidemiological Week

28th November, 2021

Highlights

- 820878 Cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 802389 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI) is the leading cause of morbidity in week 46.

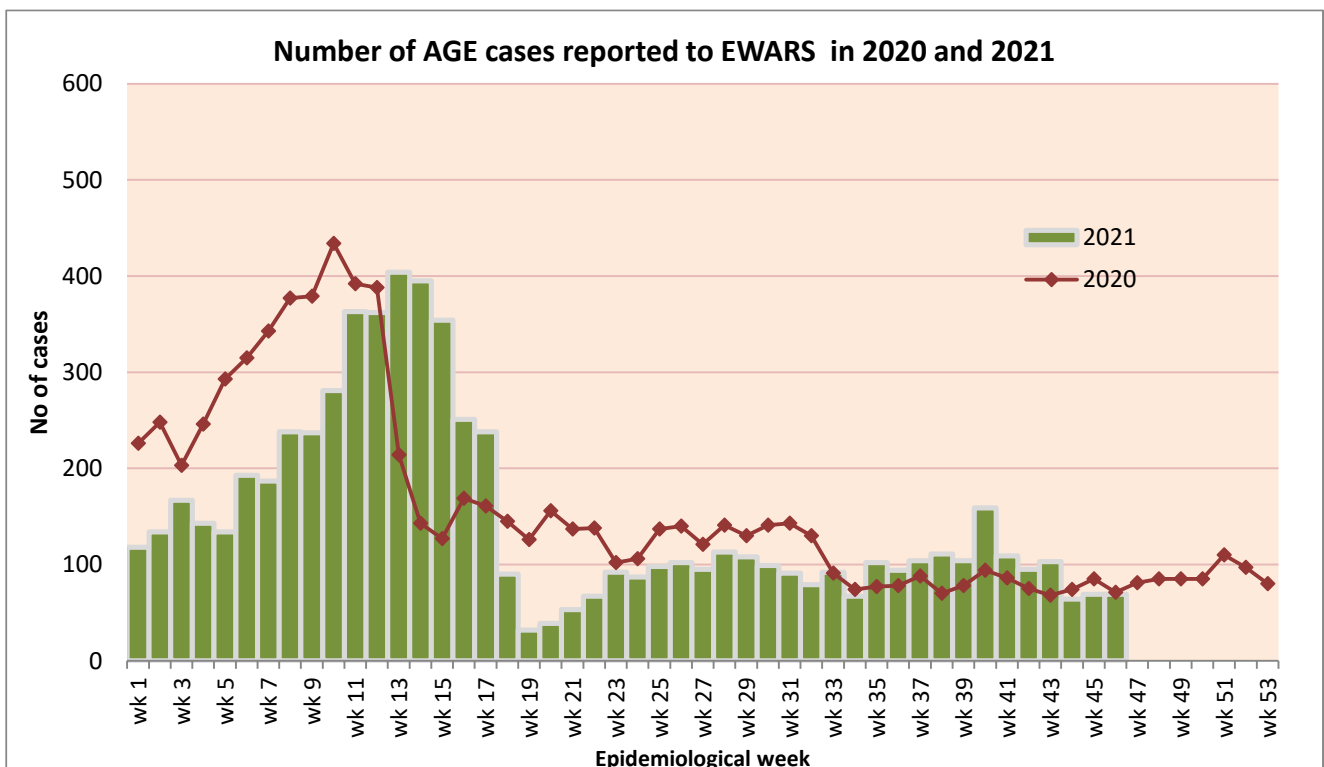
Number of cases reported for each disease this week



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

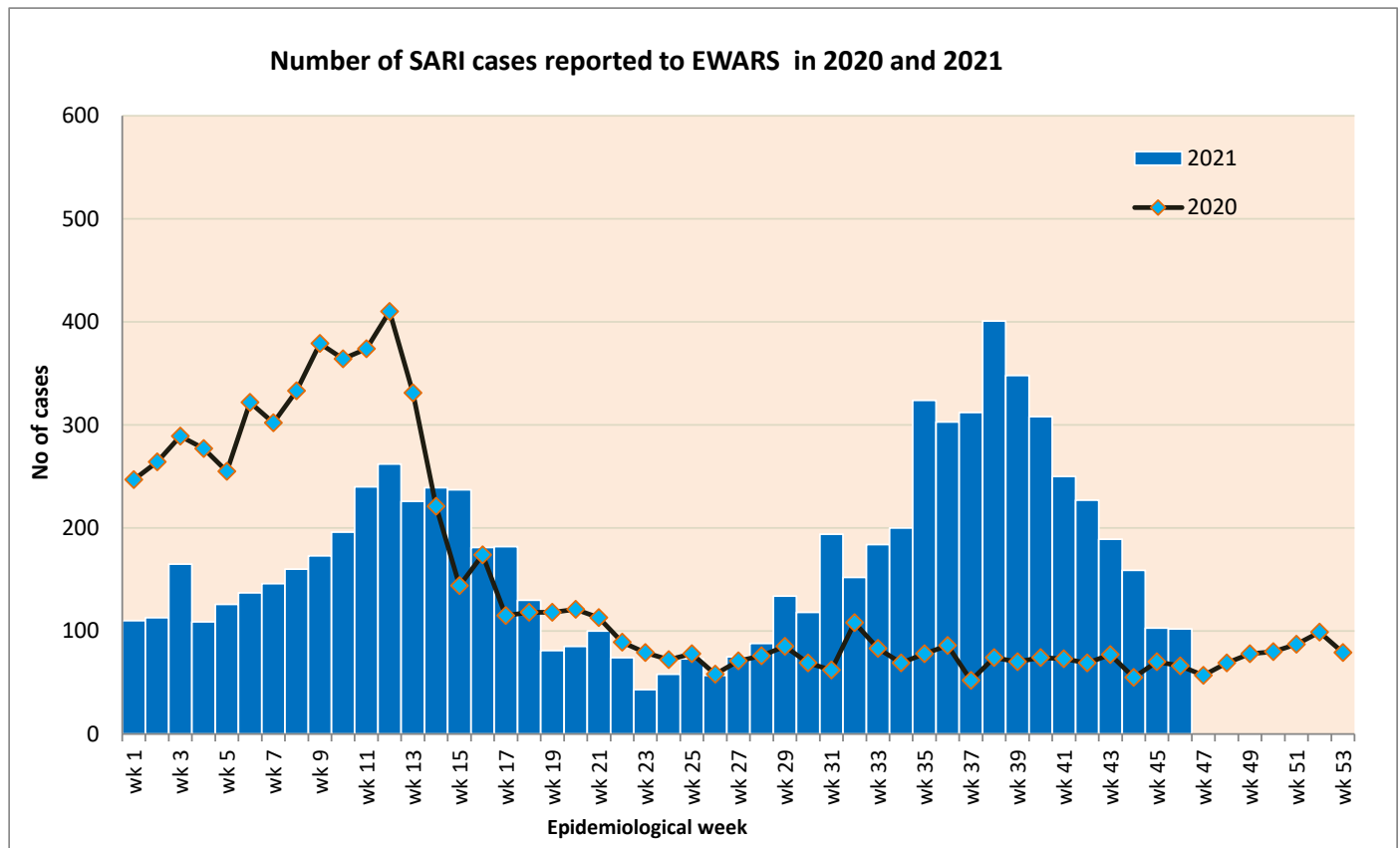
1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 69 cases of AGE were reported this week. The majority of these cases were reported from Kapilbastu (15 cases), Kathmandu (8 cases), Achham (6 cases), Siraha (4 cases).
- 71 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2020.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 102 cases of SARI were reported this week. The majority of these cases were reported from Jhapa (15 cases), Kailali (9 cases), Dailekh and Dhading (5 cases from each districts), Nawalparasi East and Julma (4 cases).
- 66 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2020.



3. Malaria

- Zero cases of malaria was reported this week
- Zero case of malaria was reported this week in 2020.

4. Dengue

- 15 cases of dengue were reported this week. The majority of these case were reported from Kathmandu (5 cases), Okhaldhunga (2cases)
- 21 cases of dengue were reported this week in 2020.

5. Kala-azar

- Seven cases of kala-azar were reported this week and the case were reported from Pyuthan (3 cases), and one each cases from Bajura, Kalikot, Okhaldhunga and Arghakhanchi districts.
- Three case of kala-azar were reported this week in 2020.

Other diseases

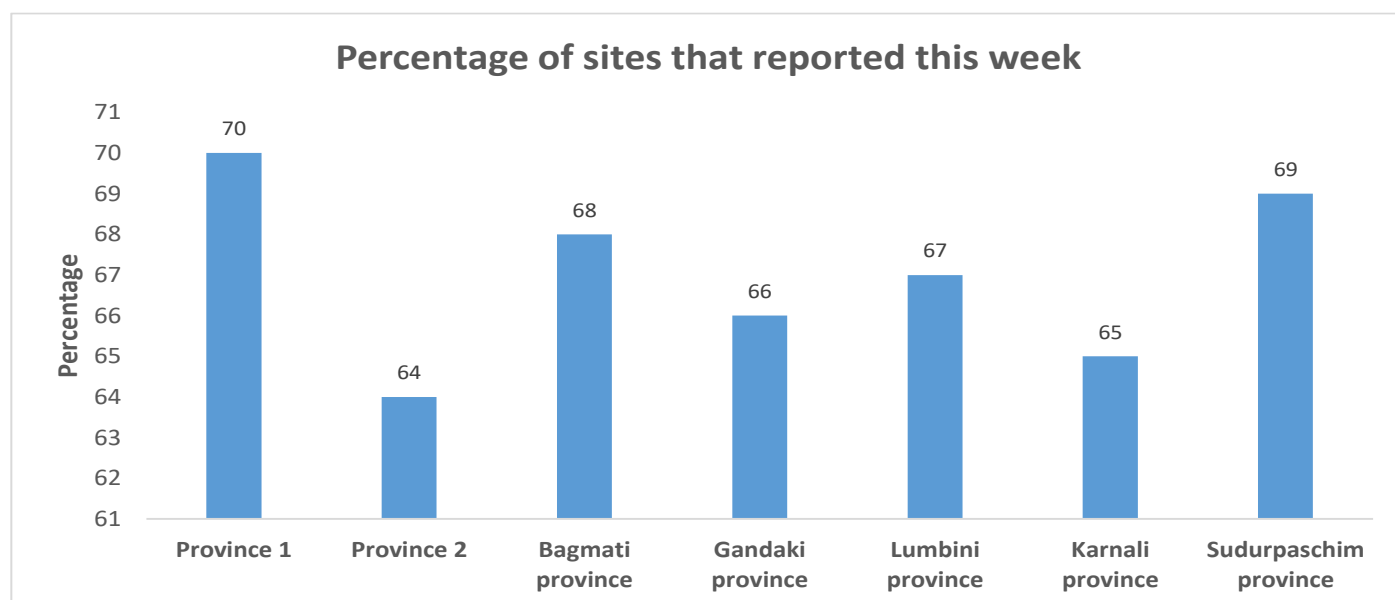
Scrub typhus

- 39 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. The majority of the cases were reported from Okhaldhunga (5 cases), Kailali and Rupandehi (4 cases from each districts), Kapilbastu and Bhojpur (3 cases from each districts).
- 18 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2020.
