

# Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal

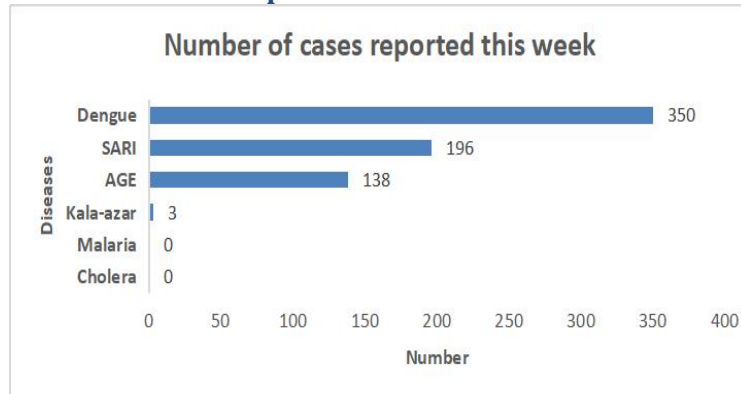
## 46<sup>th</sup> Epidemiological Week, 2023

### Sunday, 26th November, 2023

#### Highlights

- 1003442 cases of Corona Virus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991350 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, Dengue is the leading cause of morbidity in week 46.

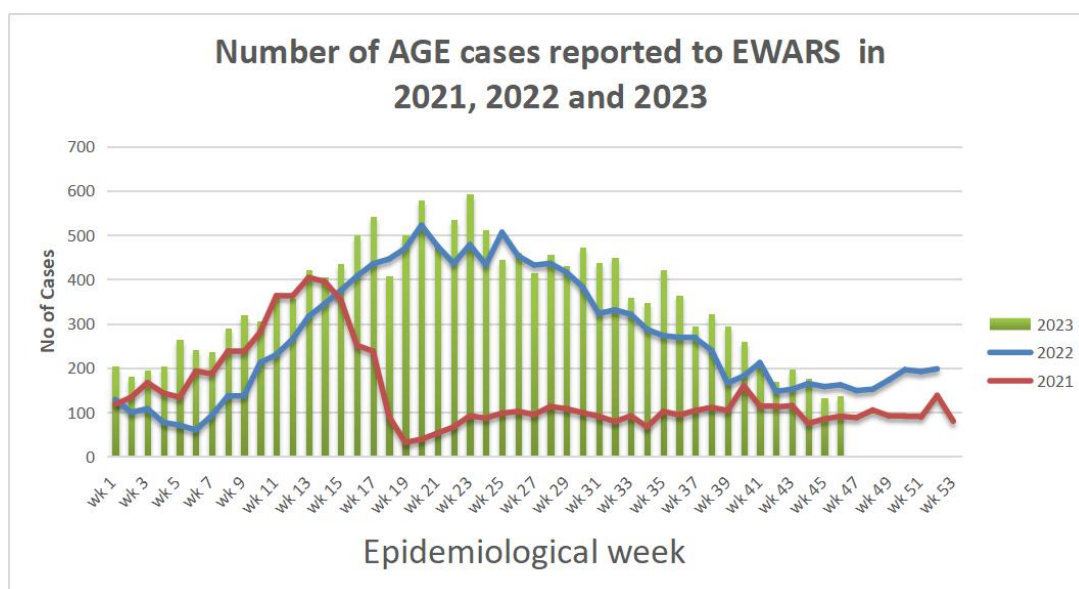
#### Number of cases reported for each disease this week



**Note:** This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

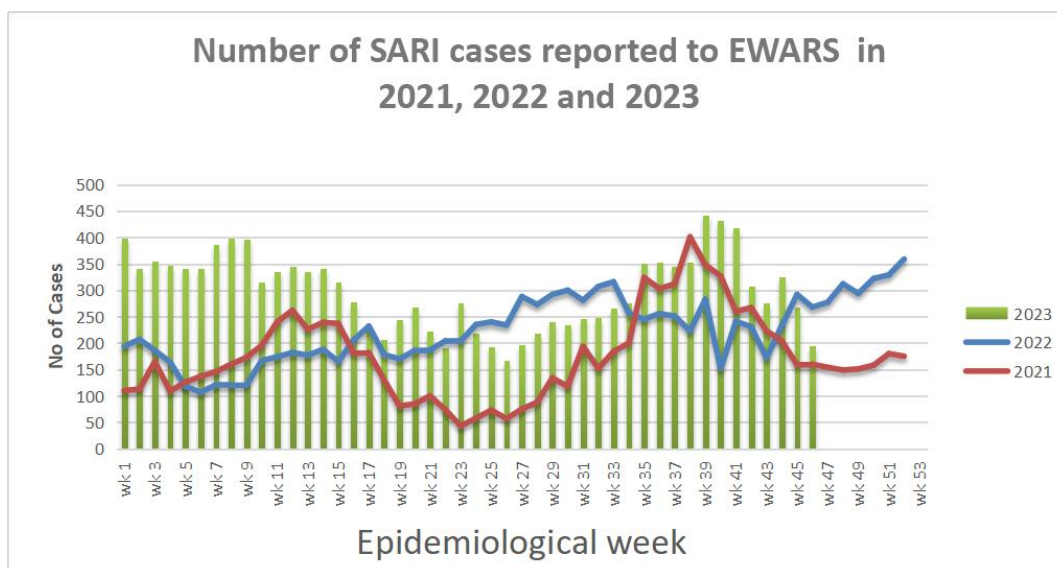
#### 1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 138 cases of AGE were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu (18 case), Bara (8 case), Parbat and Dhanusha (7 case from each district), Saptari, Mahottari and Illam ( 6 case from each district ), Bardiyaa, Parsa and Siraha ( 5 case from each district).
- 164 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2022.



#### 2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 196 cases of SARI were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Morang (26 case), Sunsari (13 case), Jumla (11 case ), Kalikot (10 case), Kathmandu and Saptari (9 case from each district).
- 269 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2022.



### 3. Malaria

- Zero case of Malaria were reported this week.
- One case of Malaria were reported this week in 2022.

### 4. Kala-azar

- Three cases of Kala-azar were reported this week. They were from Achham, Bardia and Palpa.
- Six cases of Kala-azar were reported this week in 2022.

### 5. Cholera

- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week.
- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week in 2022.

### 6. Dengue

- ♦ 350 cases of Dengue were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu (54 case), Tanahun (47 case), Kaski (38 case), Jhapa (22 case), and Bhaktapur (20 case).
- 514 cases of Dengue were reported this week in 2022.

### Other diseases

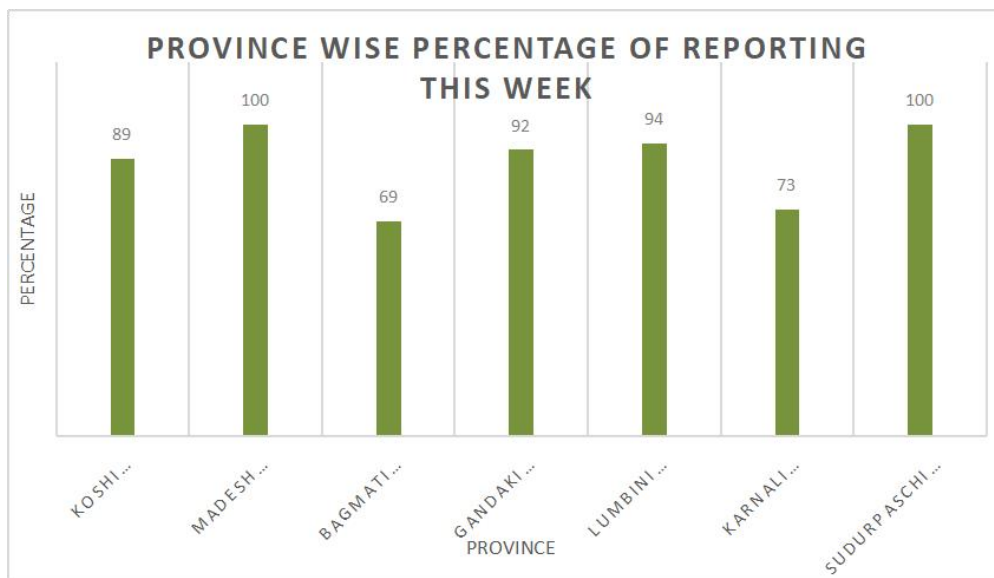
#### Scrub typhus

- 71 case of Scrub Typhus were reported this week. Of them, most of the cases were reported from, Sankhuwasabha (9 case), Kailali (8 case), Tanahu (7 case), Kanchanpur, Nawalpur East and Okhaldhunga ( 4 case from each district), Doti, Darchula, Morang and Rukum East ( 3 case from each district) .
- 79 cases of Scrub Typhus were reported this week in 2022.

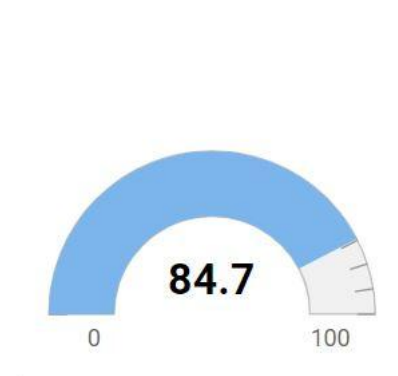
