
Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal 4th Epidemiological Week, 2024 Sunday, 4th February, 2024

Highlights


- 1003501 cases of Corona Virus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991350 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, SARI is the leading cause of morbidity in week 4.



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.


1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 123 cases of AGE were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Kathmandu and Lalitpur (11 case), Morang (8 case), Mahottari (7 case) and Bajura (6 case).
- 83 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2023.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 237 cases of SARI were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Morang (33 case), Kathmandu (30 case), Makawanpur (15 case), Jumla (13 case), and Kailali (12 case).
- 166 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2023.



3. Malaria

- Zero case of Malaria was reported this week.
- Zero case of Malaria were reported this week in 2023.

4. Kala-azar

- One case of Kala-azar was reported this week from Gulmi.
- Six cases of Kala-azar were reported this week in 2023.

5. Cholera

- No case of Cholera was reported this week.
- No case of Cholera was reported this week in 2023.

6. Dengue

- 39 cases of Dengue were reported this week. Most of these cases were reported from Jhapa (6 case), Makawanpur (5 case), Lamjung and Chitwan (4 case), two cases each from four districts including Nawalparasi East and Morang.
 - Single case of Dengue were reported this week in 2023.


Other diseases Scrub typhus

- . 22 case of Scrub Typhus were reported this week. Of them, most of the cases were reported from Lamjung (5 case), two cases each from four districts including Chitawan and Kailali.
- 27 cases of Scrub Typhus were reported this week in 2023.


