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The Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)

Highlights

AGE: 171 cases of AGE are reported this week. The majority of these cases are from Kanchanpur (21 cases), Saptari (19 cases), Dolakha (9 cases) and Lalitpur (9 cases).


SARI: 213 cases of SARI are reported this week. The majority of these cases are from Lalitpur (22 cases), Kathmandu (20 cases), Morang (19 cases), Saptari (18 cases), and Dhading (12 cases). One death from SARI is reported this week by Patan Hospital, Lalitpur and the case was from Nakkhu, Lalitpur.

Malaria: One case of Malaria is reported this week by BPKIHS, Dharan and the case was from Letang-7, Morang.

Kala-azar: Three cases of Kala-azar are reported this week, one each from Dolpa, Bajura and Dadeldhura.

The EWARS was established in 1997 to strengthen the flow of information on vector-borne and other outbreak prone infectious diseases from the district to Epidemiology and Disease Control Division (EDCD) and Vector-Borne Disease Research and Training Center (VBDRTC), Hetauda. Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) can be mobilized at short notice to facilitate prompt outbreak response at Central, Regional and District level. RRTs can also support local level health institutions for investigation and outbreak control activities.


This information system is hospital-based and is currently operational in 69 hospitals (out of 82 sites) throughout Nepal (Figure 1). So far, the EWARS mainly focuses on the **weekly reporting** of number of cases and deaths (including "zero" reports) of six priority diseases/syndromes—Malaria, Kala-azar, Dengue, Acute Gastroenteritis (AGE), Cholera and Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI), and other epidemic potential diseases/syndromes (like enteric fever). It equally focuses on **immediate reporting** (to be reported within 24 hours of diagnosis) of one confirmed case of Cholera, Kala-azar severe and complicated Malaria and one suspect/clinical case of Dengue as well as 5 or more cases of AGE and SARI from the same geographical locality in one-week period.



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
Reporting Status

Out of 69 functional EWARS sentinel sites, report was received from 38 sentinel sites (55%) whereas 31 sentinel sites did not report in the 9th epidemiological week of 2019. The reporting coverage is same as the last week.




1.1 Acute Gastro-Enteritis and Cholera

171 cases of AGE are reported in the 9th epidemiological week this year. The majority of these cases are from Kanchanpur (21 cases), Saptari (19 cases), Dolakha (9 cases) and Lalitpur (9 cases). 222 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2018.



1.2 Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

213 cases of SARI are reported in the 9th epidemiological week this year. The majority of these cases are from Lalitpur (22 cases), Kathmandu (20 cases), Morang (19 cases), Saptari (18 cases), and Dhading (12 cases). 204 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2018.



One death from SARI is reported this week by Patan Hospital, Lalitpur and the case was from Nakkhu, Lalitpur.

1.3 Enteric Fever

34 cases of Enteric fever are reported this week. The majority of the cases are from Morang (5 cases), Lamjung (4 cases), and 3 each from Dhading, Kaski and Sindhuli.

1.4 Malaria

One case of Malaria is reported this week by BPKIHS, Dharan and the case was from Letang-7, Morang. Two cases of Malaria were reported this week in 2018.

1.5 Dengue

No case of Dengue is reported this week. One case of Dengue was reported this week in 2018

1.6 Kala-azar

Three cases of Kala-azar are reported this week, one each from Dolpa, Bajura and Dadeldhura. Two cases of Kalaazar were reported this week in 2018.

1.7 Scrub typhus

Four cases of Scrub typhus are reported this week, two from Palpa and one each from Kathmandu and Parbat.
